The Board heard a report from the Investigative Unit on the following enforcement case.

**Randy Jordan:** Ms. Puckett made a motion to accept a signed Voluntary Cease and Desist Order and to close the case with additional correspondence. Mr. Pace seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

**Correspondence, Inquiries, and Items of Information:**

**Sandra S. Moore:** The Board reviewed correspondence concerning mutual continuing education agreements with other states. The Board noted that while Georgia Law does not provide the Board the authority to enter into such agreements, Board Rule 50-6-.07 (1) provides for the waiver of the professional development requirement on an individual basis upon written request, if certain conditions are met.

**Jeffrey F. Kenney:** The Board reviewed correspondence relating to the name change of the Foundation for Interior Design Education Research (FIDER) to the Council for Interior Design Accreditation. Ms. Puckett made a motion to **approve** the proposed administrative legislation. Ms. McRae seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board reviewed other miscellaneous correspondence and information that did not require a vote or action.

**NCIDO:** The Board reviewed correspondence on the Council of Delegates By-Law Change. Ms. Puckett made a motion that the Georgia Board co-sponsor the proposed amendment to Article 1X - Section 2. Ms. McRae seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board reviewed other miscellaneous correspondence and information that did not require a vote or action.

**Joint Secretary's Rule 295-15-.01, State Examining Boards Inactive Status Licenses:**

The Board reviewed recently adopted amendments to the Joint Secretary's Rule 295-15-.01 that provide the inactive status for Architects and Interior Designers. The Board may now draft amendments to Board Rules to specify inactive status requirements in accordance with the Joint Secretary's Rule.

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**Propose To Adopt Rules 50-4-.01:**

At its meeting on February 10, 2006, the Architects and Interior Designers Board voted to post 50-4-.01 – Examinations. The Board discussed revisions to its rules and considered modifications to Rule 50-4-.01 – Examinations. Ms. Puckett made a motion to propose adoption of these rules and to post and hold a public hearing to receive comments regarding the proposed rules and to consider adoption of the rules following the public hearing. In its consideration of the proposed rules, the Board stated that the formulation and adoption of these rules do not impose additional regulatory cost on any licensee that cannot be reduced by a less expensive alternative that fully accomplishes the objectives of the statutes that are the basis for the proposed rules. Further, the Board stated that it is not legal or feasible to meet the objectives of these statutes to adopt or implement differing actions for business as listed in O.C.G.A. Section 50-13-4(a)(3)(A)(B)(C) and (D) and that the formulation and adoption of these rules will impact every licensee in the same manner and each licensee is independently licensed, owned, and operated and dominant in the field of Architects and Interior Designers. Ms. McRae seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

**Other Business:**

The Board continued discussion on revisions to Rule Chapter 50-3.

Anne K. Smith and E. Camille Puckett will represent the Board at the 2006 Joint Regional Meeting of NCARB-Region 3 in Charleston, South Carolina on March 2-5, 2006.

There was no further business and the meeting was adjourned at 1:05 p.m.
