

**GEORGIA STATE BOARD OF ARCHITECTS
AND INTERIOR DESIGNERS
Board Meeting: April 6, 2007**

A meeting of the Georgia State Board of Architects and Interior Designers was held Friday, April 6, 2007, at the Office of the Division Director, Professional Licensing Boards Division, 237 Coliseum Drive, Macon, Georgia.

President Smith established that a quorum was present at 9:40 a.m. and called the meeting to order.

Ms. Puckett made a motion to **approve** the minutes of the February 9, 2007 Board meeting, February 9, 2007 Committee meeting, and the March 9, 2007 Teleconference meeting.

Mr. Maschke abstained from the voting of the February 9, 2007 Board meeting and the February 9, 2007 Committee meeting. Mr. Pace seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Ms. Love-Stanley seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Investigative Report:

The Board heard a report from the Investigative Unit on the following enforcement case:

Legislation SB237:

The Board reviewed and discussed proposed legislation, Senate Bill 237. Mr. Bolton made a motion for members to attend the upcoming legislative committee meeting and present the Board's position directly to the committee. Ms. Love-Stanley seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

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Correspondence, Inquiries, and Items of Information:

David N. Hausenman: The Board reviewed correspondence dated January 11, 2007 and took the information under advisement.

The Board reviewed other correspondence and information that did not require a vote or action.

NCARB:

The Board reviewed correspondence relative to officer elections, ARE 4.0, 2007 NCARB Annual Meeting/Conference, Region 3 Resolutions, and Region 3 minutes.

NCIDQ:

The Board reviewed correspondence regarding NCIDQ Model Language and minutes from meetings.

Ms. Puckett provided comments on the February meeting in Washington, D.C. and other items of information.

Policy:

Ms. Puckett made the following motion: Once the Board has reviewed reinstatement applications and determined that additional professional development is required, staff is administratively authorized to review the subsequent documentation and issue the license providing that requirements are met. The Board will ratify such administratively issued licenses at the next scheduled meeting. Ms. Love-Stanley seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Propose to Adopt Rule 50-3:

At its meeting on April 6, 2007, the Architects and Interior Designers Board voted to post 50-3 – Firms, Partnerships, Corporations – Proper Names - Architects. The Board discussed revisions to its rules and considered modifications to Rule 50-3 – Firms, Partnerships, Corporations – Proper Names - Architects. Ms. Puckett made a motion to propose adoption of these rules and to post and hold a public hearing to receive comments regarding the proposed rules and to consider adoption of the rules following the public hearing. In its consideration of the proposed rules, the Board stated that the formulation and adoption of these rules do not impose additional regulatory cost on any licensee that cannot be reduced by a less expensive alternative that fully accomplishes the objectives of the statutes that are the basis for the proposed rules. Further, the Board stated that it is not legal or feasible to meet the objectives of these statutes to adopt or implement differing actions for business as listed in O.C.G.A. Section 50-13-4(a)(3)(A)(B)(C) and (D) and that the formulation and adoption of these rules will impact every licensee in the same manner and each licensee is independently licensed, owned, and operated and dominant in the field of Architects and Interior Designers. Mr. Maschke seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

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Other Business:

There was no further business and the meeting was adjourned at 1:27 p.m.
