Discussion was held as to who supported and who opposed Senate Bill 28 as written. Camille Puckett and Laurie McRae were in favor of the motion. Niles Bolton, David Maschke, Jim Mehserle, Andrew Pace and Ivenue Love-Stanley opposed the motion. The motion did not pass.

A motion was made by Ivenue Love-Stanley, seconded by Jim Mehserle, to oppose Senate Bill 28 as written. Camille Puckett and Laurie McRae opposed the motion. Niles Bolton, David Maschke, Jim Mehserle, Andrew Pace, Ivenue Love-Stanley and Anne Smith were in favor of the motion. The motion passed.
