**Board Meeting: June 18, 2010**

Chairperson Smith established that a quorum was present at 9:45 a.m. and called the meeting to order.

**Approval of Minutes**

Chairperson Smith called for any changes/revisions to the minutes of the April 16, 2010 full Board meeting, April 19, 2010 Conference Call and the May 14, 2010 Conference Call.

A motion was made by Camille Puckett, seconded by Andrew Pace, and the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the April 16, 2010 full Board meeting, April 19, 2010 Conference Call and the May 14, 2010 Conference Call as presented.

**Written Correspondence**

**Correspondence from Jerrell Williams:** The Board reviewed correspondence from Mr. Williams. The Board directed staff to send the appropriate response and refer Mr. Williams to O.C.G.A. § 43-4-10(b) and O.C.G.A. § 43-4-1(10).

**Correspondence from Richard Spalding:** The Board reviewed correspondence from Mr. Spalding requesting that the imposed fine from the Cease and Desist Order of \$5,000 be removed or reduced. A motion was made by Jim Mehserle, seconded by David Maschke, and the Board voted unanimously to amend the Cease and Desist Order issued to Richard W. Spalding (docketed April 20, 2010) by upholding the fine as indicated, but allow a payment plan of 12 monthly payments. The Board would also like to include in the Order that the Board reviewed the documentation that Mr. Spalding submitted and remind him that the architect, in addition to being a member, must be in responsible control of all projects as stated in O.C.G.A. § 43-4-10(b).

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**Correspondence from Darryl Bray:** The Board reviewed correspondence from Mr. Bray. The Board directed staff to send the appropriate response and applicable code section.

**Correspondence from Ronald Dimery:** The Board reviewed correspondence from Mr. Dimery. The Board directed staff to send the appropriate response.

**Correspondence from Pat Dunwoody:** The Board reviewed correspondence regarding how this company can offer its attendees continuing education credits. The Board voted unanimously to have staff respond by stating that individuals can choose to self-report the seminar courses, but the credits will not be counted towards public protection subjects (health, safety and welfare). Another option is that, as a provider, she can go through the certification process with AIA (American Institute of Architects) and provide the official certificate.

**Other Business**

**Interior Designer Seals:** The Board reviewed two proposed versions of an interior designer seal. A motion was made by Jim Mehserle, seconded by Niles Bolton, to adopt the version of the seal presented by Ms. Puckett as the official seal of a Georgia Registered Interior Designer. Discussion was held. After no further discussion, the motion was amended by Jim Mehserle to include that the thickness of the line be reduced and made more consistent all the way around. Motion passed.

Ms. Wray stated that a rule will need to be promulgated in order to officially adopt the seal. Ms. Battle further stated that once the rule is drafted, the Board can vote to post via conference call.

**Committee Reports**

Chairperson Smith stated that there are many inconsistencies in the Board's rules. She stated that she would like for the Board members to work on several issues such as getting a copy of the applications and fee schedule to review for any inconsistencies. She would like for Mr. Maschke to take a closer look at the reinstatement policy and report back to the Board. In regards to reinstatement fees, she asked Mr. Pace to do a survey of what the fees are in other states and report back to the Board.

With no other business for the Board to discuss, a motion was made by Jim Mehserle, seconded by Niles Bolton, and Board voted unanimously to adjourn the meeting at 12:45 p.m.
