### **Other Business:**

**NCARB Report:** Anne Smith presented a report on changes proposed to programs by NCARB for Board comment.

**BEA:** Anne Smith presented proposed changes for recommendation to NCARB of the Broadly Experienced Architect Program. The Board unanimously agreed with the proposals. The Board expressed their desire to see clear and sufficient experience requirements included in the final draft.

**BEFA:** Anne Smith presented proposed changes to the Broadly Experienced Foreign Architect Program. Proposed changes include a required number of years of licensure in home country or in

the U.S. under the direct supervision of an architect in responsible control, and requirement to take ARE to be licensed in the United States. The Board unanimously agreed with the proposal.

**IDP:** Anne Smith presented proposed changes to the Intern Development Program. The Board unanimously expressed their disagreement with the proposal to only require completion of core hours. The Board agreed with the proposal to require interns to document hours in 6 experience categories that directly align with the six phase-based areas of the practice of architecture.

**Data-sharing:** Anne Smith presented latest information on a proposal for data-sharing with other states' licensing boards for architecture.

**Dues:** The increase previously approved was eliminated. There will not be any dues increase in the immediate future.

The next meeting of the Board will be held on October 17, 2014 at 9:30 a.m. at the Professional Licensing Boards Office in Macon, GA.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 11:40 a.m.
