Minutes Approved at the February 6, 2006 Meeting

The Georgia Auctioneers Commission held its regular meeting on December 5, 2005 at 237 Coliseum Drive, Macon, Georgia. Chairman Terry Hansford called the meeting to order at 10:10 a.m.

A quorum was established with members present being: Terry Hansford, Chairman, Charlie Gay, Cognizant Member, Mark Manley, Board Member, Roy Cates, Board Member and Paul Brower, Board Member.

Others present were: Steve Lindsey, Executive Director, Gretchen Dees, Assistant Attorney General, Jo Ann Lyde, Application Specialist and Valencier Brown, Board Secretary.

Approval of Minutes:

Mr. Cates made a motion to accept the minutes of the October 17, 2005 meeting. Mr. Gay seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Adoption of Agenda:

Mr. Manley made the motion to adopt today's agenda. Mr. Cates seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Election of Officers:

The Board voted and elected new officers. Mr. Hansford motioned to nominate himself as the new Board Cognizant. Mr. Brower seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Mr. Hansford motioned to nominate Mark Manley as Vice Chairman. Mr. Brower seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Mr. Gay nominated Mr. Cates as Chairman. Mr. Manley seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Executive Session:

Mr. Manley made a motion to enter into Executive Session to deliberate on applications, complaint matters, and to receive information on investigations. Mr. Brower seconded the motion. Motion carried by Mr. Hansford, Mr. Gay, and Mr. Cates.

Motion seconded by Mr. Brower. Motion carried.

Mr. Manley motioned to accept the Cease and Desist Order on David and Melissa Bell and to issue a \$500.00 fine for violating the Cease and Desist Order after signing. Mr. Manley further motioned to refer the case to the DA's office for criminal prosecution. Motion seconded by Mr. Cates. Motion carried.

Mr. Cates motioned to accept the Consent Order on Hudson and Marshall, Inc. Motion seconded by Mr. Manley. Motion carried.

New Business

Mr. Manley motioned to authorize staff to administratively schedule In-State Auctioneers to take the Auctioneer Exam upon receipt of a completed application. The Board will review applications containing possible disqualifying information. Motion seconded by Mr. Cates.
Motion carried.

The Board instructed the staff to conduct the same percentage audit of renewals for continuing education compliance used for the previous renewals.
