## **Old Business**

Mr. Brower motioned to amend the proposed legislation law O.C.G.A Section 13-3-6 Section 1. Mr. Manley seconded. Motion carried. The proposed legislation law O.C.G.A 13-3-6 will be amended as follows:

“13-3-6.

- (a) The placement and acceptance of a winning bid ~~at~~ in an absolute auction, or after any reserve has been met in a reserve auction, conducted by an auctioneer licensed under Chapter 6 of the Title 43 shall constitute a valid and binding contract.
- (b) The failure of either party to complete the sale and purchase pursuant to a contract subject to subsection (a) o f this Code section shall entitle the other party to compensatory damages. In addition, if the property which was the subject of the contract has a value of more than \$1000.00, the party not at fault shall be entitled to recover from the party at fault exemplary damages in the amount of 10 percent of the value of the property but not more than \$1000.00.”

Mr. Hansford motioned that Section (b) remain as is. Mr. Gay seconded. Motion carried.

## **Adjournment**

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 1:30 p.m.
