

Minutes
Georgia Auctioneers Commission
Monday, June 19, 2006 10:00 a.m.

The Georgia Auctioneers Commission held its regular meeting on June 19, 2006 at 237 Coliseum Drive, Macon, Georgia. Vice-Chairman Mark Manley called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m.

A quorum was established with the following members present: Mark Manley, Vice-Chairman, Terry Hansford, Charlie Gay, Norman Echols, and Paul Brower.

Others present were Steve Lindsey, Executive Director, JoAnn Lyde, Application Specialist, and Gretchen Dees, Assistant Attorney General.

Approval of Minutes:

Mr. Echols moved, Mr. Brower seconded, and the Commission approved the minutes of the April 17, 2006 meeting.

Adoption of the Agenda:

Mr. Echols moved, Mr. Hansford seconded, and the Commission approved the agenda with an amendment to allow an appearance by James M. Jackson to discuss his application for reinstatement.

James M. Jackson appeared before the Commission to discuss the reinstatement of his auctioneer license. The Commission advised him that Commission rules firmly require all reinstatement applicants to submit to and pass the Auctioneer examination as a condition of reinstatement.

Executive Session:

Mr. Hansford moved, Mr. Gay seconded, and the Commission voted to enter into Executive Session to deliberate on applications, complaint matters, Attorney General Report, investigations.
