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Uladia Taylor moved, Roy Cates seconded, and the Board voted to accept the report of pending cases presented by the Attorney General's office.

Uladia Taylor moved, Roy Cates seconded, and the Board voted to accept the recommendations made on the following items of other business:

Roy Cates moved, Uladia Taylor seconded, and the Board voted to amend Board Rule 55-6-.01(4), changing the Recovery Fund fee from \$150.00 to \$0. The change will suspend collection of the \$150.00 fee normally contributed to the Education, Research and Recovery Fund until such time as the Board makes any appropriate changes.

Roy Cates moved, Uladia Taylor seconded, and the Board voted to accept a proposal, subject to approval by the Attorney General, to eliminate the affidavit page of the Auctioneer applications. The affidavits would be replaced by a series of close-ended

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questions to obtain relatively similar information currently provided by the affidavit. The changes will aid in creating an on-line application for future applicants.

The Board discussed forming a committee to include the board members along with diverse members of trade and industry organizations to create an ethics course that would be provided by the Commission and funded by the Auctioneer Commission's Education, Recovery and Research fund.
