

The Georgia Board of Chiropractic Examiners met on April 26, 2005 at the Professional Licensing Boards Division, 237 Coliseum Drive in Macon, Georgia for the purpose of conducting business.

Dr. Patterson moved and Dr. Mathiak seconded and the Board voted to enter into Executive Session in accordance with O.C.G.A. §43-1-2(k)(1)(2), O.C.G.A. § 50-14-2(1), O.C.G.A. § 43-1-2(k)(4) and O.C.G.A. § 43-1-1-19(4) to deliberate and receive information on applications and disciplinary matters. The Board concluded Executive Session in order to vote on these matters and to continue with the public session.

President Wren established that a quorum was present, and called the meeting to order at 10:10 A.M.

Minutes: Dr. Sallarulo moved and Dr. Mathiak seconded and the Board voted to approve the Minutes from the March 10, 2005 Board Meeting and the March 17, 2005 Conference Call.

Charles Weiss, DC, Jay DiVagno, DC, Vincent Veneziano, DC, Todd Kohout, DC: Request for board's position on insurance company denial of charges to various CPT billing codes by chiropractors. **Board response:** Ms. Thomas and Dr. Wren will formulate a letter stating the board's position that the referenced CPT codes are within the chiropractic scope of practice. The letter will be kept on file for responding to future queries of this nature. The Board will consider adopting a policy on this matter at their July 2005 meeting.

MD/DC : The board requested that staff query other states for information on policies, procedures, rules and regulations addressing MD/DC and MD/PT practices. Board will formulate ideas and work on drafting a policy or rule at their June 7th work session in Macon.

The Board decided to schedule two meetings prior to the July 14th meeting in order to work on drafting rules, reviewing policies, and to handle reinstatement applications. The following dates and agenda items were decided upon:

- 2) June 7, 2005: Reinstatement Applications, MD/DC rules/policies;

LEGISLATIVE UPDATES: Ms. Thomas gave the board an update and summary on the following legislation which passed during the 2005 legislative session:

- 1) House Bill 166: Volunteers in Medicine Act
Dr. Anchors moved and Dr. Sallarulo seconded and the Board voted to accept the sample application provided, with appropriate changes to reflect the chiropractic profession; board staff will have the revised application available for further review/approval at the June 7th work session.

- 2) House Bill 266: Chiropractic Scope of Practice; authority to expunge advertising violation; authority to order mental/physical evaluations. The Board will work on drafting appropriate rules.
- 3) Senate Bill 258: Renewal of professional licenses for Military Service Members; The Board will work on drafting a rule to incorporate these provisions.

CONTINUING EDUCATION RULE: Rule 100-5-.01 Hours Required. Amended – consider for vote to post.

Dr. Mathiak moved and Dr. Anchors seconded and the Board voted to post the Notice of Intent to Adopt and Notice of Hearing for the proposed rule change to Rule 100.5.01 for no less than 30 days prior to July 14, 2005 when the Board will hold a hearing on the rule and intent to adopt the proposed rule change as follows:

Rule 100-5-.01 Hours Required. Amended

(1) Each licensed chiropractor is required to obtain a minimum of twenty (20) hours of Board-approved continuing education annually in order to renew his/her license biennially. No more than one-half of the required continuing education hours per year may be obtained through the internet or self-study.

(a) Courses dealing entirely with practice building or practice management will not be accepted by the Board for the purpose of satisfying the requirement of O.C.G.A. § 43-9-11.

(b) Each licensed chiropractor shall maintain in his/her own possession certificates of attendance at continuing education meetings for a period of 4 years from the date of the program.

(c) Each doctor of chiropractic is responsible for determining in advance that the courses which he/she proposes to attend are sponsored by an approved provider.

(2) Successful licensure candidates are automatically exempt from meeting the continuing education requirement in the calendar year said candidate is licensed.

Dr. Mathiak moved and Dr. Anchors seconded and the Board voted that the formulation and adoption of this rule does not impose regulatory cost on any licensee and any cost to comply with the proposed rule cannot be reduced by a less expensive alternative that fully accomplishes the objectives of O.C.G.A. §§43-1-4,43-1-7, 43-1-25, 43-11A-7, 43-11A-14.

Dr. Mathiak moved and Dr. Anchors seconded and the Board voted that it is not legal or feasible to meet the objectives of O.C.G.A. §§43-1-4,43-1-7, 43-1-25, 43-11A-7, 43-11A-14.to adopt or implement differing actions for businesses as listed at O.C.G.A. §§50-13-4(3)(A), (B), (C) and (D). The formulation and adoption of this rule will impact every licensee in the same manner and each licensee is independently licensed, owned and operated and dominant in the field of Chiropractic.
