March 29, 2007

A meeting of the Georgia Board of Chiropractic was held via teleconference on Thursday, March 29, 2007, at the Professional Licensing Boards, 237 Coliseum Drive, Macon, Georgia.

Karen Mathiak established that a quorum was present and the meeting was **called to order** at 12:33 pm.

Dr. Wren made a motion, Dr. Baker seconded and the Board **voted** to enter into **Executive Session** in accordance with O.C.G.A-§ 43-1-2(k) to deliberate and receive information on applications. Voting in favor of the motion were those present who included Drs. Nelson and Sallarulo. The Board concluded Executive Session in order to vote on the matters and to continue with the public session.

Consideration of renewal of licensure due to delinquent C.E.'s for 2006 on D.E.P., D.C. -

Dr. Baker motioned, Dr. Wren seconded and the Board voted to deny. The documentation course taken December 3-4, 2005 from the University of Bridgeport was not accepted by board rule. Licensee needs nineteen (19) additional hours before 03/31/07 or license will lapse for non-renewal. If hours are received by 4/2/07 license will be renewed under a public consent order and \$500 fine. The Board voted to accept the consent order upon receipt.

Consideration of renewal of licensure due to delinquent C.E.'s for 2005 and 2006 on

G.L.S., D.C. - Dr. Baker motioned, Dr. Wren seconded and the Board voted to deny. The documentation course taken 12/31/06 from the University of Bridgeport was not accepted by board rule. Licensee needs two additional hours before 03/31/07 or license will lapse for non-renewal. If hours are received by 4/2/07 license will be renewed under a public consent order and \$500 fine. The Board voted to accept the consent order upon receipt.

Consideration of renewal of licensure due to delinquent C.E.'s for 2005 and 2006 on

H.M.B., D.C. - Dr. Nelson motioned, Dr. Baker seconded and the Board voted to renew license with a \$500 fine and a public consent order. The Board voted to accept the consent order upon receipt.

Consideration of renewal of licensure due to delinquent C.E.'s for 2005 on S.G.W., D.C.

- Dr. Sallarulo motioned and Dr. Wren seconded and the Board voted to renew license with a \$500 fine and a public consent order. The Board voted to accept the consent order upon receipt.

Consideration of renewal of licensure due to delinquent C.E.'s for 2005 on C.A.H., D.C. -

Dr. Wren motioned, Dr. Nelson seconded and the Board voted to renew license with a \$500 fine and a public consent order. The Board voted to accept the consent order upon receipt.

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Consideration of renewal of licensure due to delinquent C.E.'s for 2005 on T.M.S., D.C. - Dr. Sallarulo motioned, Dr. Wren seconded and the Board voted to deny. Licensee needs twenty additional hours before 3/31/07 or license will lapse for non-renewal. If hours are received by 4/2/07 license will be renewed under a public consent order and \$500 fine.

Consideration of renewal of licensure due to delinquent C.E.'s for 2005 on L.M.F., D.C. - Dr. Baker made a motion, Dr. Wren seconded and the board voted to approve renewal under a consent order with a \$500 fine. The Board voted to accept the consent order upon receipt.

Consideration of renewal of licensure due to delinquent C.E.'s for 2005 on J.M.D., D.C. - Dr. Sallarulo motioned, Dr. Wren seconded and board voted to approve renewal with a \$500 fine and public consent order. The Board voted to accept the consent order upon receipt.

Consideration of renewal of licensure due to arrest on S.M.L., D.C.- Dr. Nelson motioned, Dr. Sallarulo seconded and the Board voted to deny and have licensee appear before the board at April meeting. License will remain on renewal pending until reviewed by board at April meeting.

Correspondence from Dr. Bruce Hoffman re: R.C., D.C. returning to practice- Dr. Sallarulo motioned, Dr. Wren seconded and the board voted to have licensee appear before the board at April meeting.

Consideration of counter-offer concerning consent order on M.K., D.C. - Dr. Sallarulo motioned, Dr. Wren seconded and the board voted to deny request for private consent order and deny the request to reduce the fine to \$2500. The board voted to increase fine from \$5000 to \$6000.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 2:00 pm on March 29, 2007.
