Consideration of Board Rule 100-4-.02. Dr. Wren made a motion to adopt Board Rule 100-4-.02. Dr. Baker seconded the motion and it carried unanimously

Consideration of adoption of Board Rule 100-17-.01. Dr. Baker made a motion to adopt Board Rule 100-17-.01. Dr. Nelson seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Correspondence from Dr. Howard Golden. Dr Baker made a motion to uphold the Board's decision to deny. The Board has a concern that Dr. Golden does not note D.C. or Chiropractic on his letters or his website. Ms. Bowen seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Request from Butler Chiropractic, Dr. Michael Butler re: Informed Consent Dr. Nelson made a motion to notify Dr. Butler that informed consent is not currently legally required for

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chiropractors in Georgia. However, Board Rules may be amended in the future to make such a requirement. Dr. Wren seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Request from Dr. Miriam Watkins. Dr. Baker made a motion that the Board can consider modalities certification when she provides information from Brenau college as Georgia law §43-9-16 requires completion of a 120 hour course. Ms. Bowen seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Rule Waiver Request from Lee Carroll re: Board Rule 100-5-.01. Dr. Nelson made a motion to approve the Rule Waiver request to take all CE on-line. Dr. Wren seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Correspondence from Albert Pashman, D.C. Dr. Nelson made a motion to allow indefinite extension on the SPEC requirement and allow utilization of 5 CE hours from 2008 to count toward 2009 20 CE hour requirement. Dr. Wren seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
