Dr. Mathiak established that a quorum was present and the meeting that was scheduled to begin at 8:00a.m., was called to order at 8:02 a.m.

Open Session

Consideration of Amendment to a Final Decision on William Sayer, D.C. –

Dr. Wren made a motion to remove the condition requiring a refresher course through the PEAK program; instead requiring Dr. Sayer work the under supervision of a Board approved D.C. for not less than 40 hours. At the end of that period, the supervisor must write the Board and declare that Dr. Sayer is safe to practice with reasonable skill and safety to the public. Dr. Nelson seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Executive Session

Dr. Wren made a motion, Ms. Campbell seconded, and the Board voted to enter into **Executive Session** in accordance with O.C.G.A. §43-1-19(h)(2), 43-11-47(h) and §43-1-2(k) to deliberate on applications, disciplinary matters and to receive information on applications and pending board orders. Voting in favor of the motion were those present who included Dr. Nelson. The Board concluded the **Executive Session** in order to vote on these matters and continue with the public session.

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Attorney General Executive Session – Ms. Amy Morelli

During this time, Dr. K cannot accept insurance payments – cash only. Once the criminal sentence is rendered, require that he sign the voluntary surrender that will be accepted upon receipt
