**Open Session Minutes**

The Investigative Committee of the Georgia Board of Chiropractic Examiners met on Thursday, June 4, 2015 at 237 Coliseum Drive, Macon, Georgia, 31217. The meeting was called to order at 9:15a.m. Dr. Karen Mathiak moved and Dr. Andrew Krantz seconded the motion to enter into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing investigative cases and to conduct investigative interviews as authorized by O.C.G.A. Sections 43-1-2(h) and 43-11-47(h). The motion carried unanimously.

At the conclusion of the Executive Session, Karen Mathiak, D.C. declared the meeting open pursuant to the Open and Public Meeting Act, O.C.G.A. §§ 50-14-1 et seq. The Investigative Committee entered a unanimous vote to present the recommendations to the Board as indicated below.

Recommendations  
Refer to Attorney General for a Private Consent Agreement for violation of Board rule 100-7-.04. Require that respondent complete 4 hours of additional, in person Georgia Law Continuing Education given by different instructors for each hour of study within 6 months of docketing the order. Pay \$500 fine for rule violation and probationary licensure status for 2 years.

CHIR150053

Table and schedule another appointment time at an upcoming Board Meeting.

CHIR150054

Instruct the respondent to provide the Board with a certified copy of the indictment and accusation documents to present to the Board for review before issuing a license.

CHIR150055

Respondent to obtain a certified copy accusation, indictment and disposition records from the 2011 arrest, a certified copy of the legal name change order and results of a Mental Physical Examination prior to upcoming Board meeting July 10, 2015.

CHIR150056

Issue license with a Letter of Concern regarding criminal history and instructions to consider taking Continuing Education in person. Remind the respondent not to practice using physical agent modalities when not certified to do so in the state of Georgia.

CHIR150058

Close the case and Issue the License

Affirm prior decision of the Board to lapse the license due to failure to meet the renewal application requirements and require the respondent to reinstate. Notify the respondent that all information required on the application and requested by the Board must be submitted before reinstatement can be considered.

At the conclusion of the Executive Session, Dr. Mathiak declared the meeting open pursuant to the Open and Public Meeting Act, O.C.G.A. §50-14-1 et seq. No votes were taken during executive session.

There being no further business to come before the committee, the meeting adjourned at 12:00p.m.
