The Investigative Committee of the Georgia Board of Chiropractic Examiners met on Friday, April 22, 2016 at 237 Coliseum Drive, Macon, Georgia, 31217. Refer to investigations to conduct a site visit to determine if the respondent is engaging in unlicensed practice and obtain additional information about the respondent's licensing and credentials.

Refer to investigations to determine if a Physical Therapist is working at the practice, obtain billing statements to determine if modality services have been provided, and obtain any brochures, literature, a menu of services, prices, as are available

CHIR160057

Close the case, out of jurisdiction.


Miscellaneous:
