Open Session Minutes

The Investigative Committee of the Georgia Board of Chiropractic Examiners met on Friday, August 26, 2016 at 237 Coliseum Drive, Macon, Georgia, 31217. 
Request that respondent obtain a letter from his treating physician regarding his condition for consideration by the Board and a statement attesting that the respondent can practice with reasonable skill and safety.
