2. Informed the board that Inspector Rosemary Hester is out of work on Medical Leave.

**Winston Strickland moved, Virgil Ergle seconded, and the board voted unanimously to enter Executive Session in accordance with O.C.G.A.c 43-1-2(k) and 43-1-9(h) to deliberate on applications and enforcement matters and to review information on applications and investigate reports. ### **Legal Service Report**

Sally Hatcher presented a report of applicants who have convictions.

**The board concluded Executive Session in order to vote on these matters and to continue public session.**

The board instructed the administrative staff to send IP/apprentice a letter recommending that he enter a barber school training program because not enough documentation was presented to indicate that he has accumulated apprentice hours that were not submitted by TV/master.

**Charles Manning moved, Virgil Ergle seconded, and the board voted unanimously** to deny the request of the owner of BBS/Tifton to waive a portion of citation fees and reinstate the shop license, extending thirty (30) days for payment in full of the citation amount and informing the owner that until he pays \$300 for reinstatement of his shop license, he is subject to further inspection fines.

**Winston Strickland moved, Charles Manning seconded, and the board voted unanimously** to close the cases presented by Enforcement (BAR05003, and BAR040173).

**Charles Manning moved, Lutha Crump seconded, and the board voted unanimously** to approve the signed consent orders of the following:

**Virgil Ergle moved, Lutha Crump seconded, and the board voted unanimously** to dismiss the following citations and request the salons are re-inspected. If the salons are found to be operating, a Cease and Desist Order be issued:

**Winston Strickland moved, Virgil Ergle seconded, and the board voted unanimously** that when applicants who have committed serious offenses or are currently on probation are approved, a consent order is attached to the license requiring that the licensee immediately report any future arrest or conviction for a designated period of time to the board.

**Winston Strickland moved, Charles Manning seconded, and the board voted unanimously** SRD,I/Shop is approved with a consent order requiring that the licensee immediately report any future arrest or conviction for a period of two years to the board.

**Lutha Crump moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the board voted unanimously** to approve the applications of MEK/apprentice.

**Winston Strickland moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the board voted unanimously** to approve the application of PDG/reinstate attaching a consent order that immediately places the license on suspension for three months.

**Winston Strickland moved, Virgil Ergle seconded, and the board voted unanimously** to approve the application of GIB/apprentice with a consent order requiring that the licensee immediately report any future arrest or conviction for a period of two years to the board.

**Lutha Crump moved, Winston Strickland seconded, and the board voted unanimously** to approve the application of ELH/apprentice with a consent order requiring that the licensee immediately report any future arrest or conviction for six years to the board.

**Charles Manning moved, Virgil Ergle seconded, and the board voted unanimously** to approve the application of DS/endorse with a consent order requiring that the licensee immediately report any future arrest or conviction for a period of 6 years to the board.
