4. Submitted a report of Board Cost Versus Revenue Analysis for FY2003 and FY2004.

The board requested that Ms. Surrency obtain the following information and data for the June 2005 board meeting:

- a. A copy from previous FY Board Versus Revenue Analysis reports
- b. Information indicating if citations funds were included in the reports

5. Previewed the NIC National Endorsement Survey with board members.

6. Informed the board members that an NIC Textbook Reference Survey was included in the meeting packets.

Winston Strickland moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the board voted unanimously to enter Executive Session in accordance with O.C.G.A.c43-1-2(k) and 43-1-9(h) to deliberate on applications and enforcement matters and to review information on applications and investigate reports. Voting in favor of the motion were Winston Strickland, Virgil Egle, and Lutha Crump, and Lorena Barrios.

The board concluded Executive Session in order to vote on these matters and to continue public session.

Winston Strickland moved, Virgil Egle seconded, and the board voted unanimously to refer H&SBS/Macon to Enforcement to seek a Cease and Desist Order because of unlicensed practice.

Winston Strickland moved, Virgil Egle seconded, and the board voted unanimously to approve the accept the apprentice hours of RQ/barber and approve him to sit for the master barber examination.

Lutha Crump moved, Winston Strickland seconded, and the board voted unanimously to close the following Enforcement cases: BAR050043, BAR050046, BAR050033.

Lutha Crump moved, Winston Strickland seconded, and the board voted unanimously to accept the following signed Cease and Desist Orders:

Winston Strickland moved, Virgil Egle seconded, and the board voted unanimously to approve the application of HLM/barberappr attaching a consent order that the license is placed on probation for two years and the licensee must immediately report any future arrests or convictions to the Board.

Virgil Egle moved, Lutha Crump seconded, and the board voted unanimously to approve the application of LKL/barberrenewal attaching a consent order suspending the license for three months then placing the license on probation until December 16, 2008.

Winston Strickland moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the board voted unanimously to approve the application of TAM/barber renewal attaching a consent order that the license is placed on probation until September 19, 2007 and the licensee must immediately report any future arrests or convictions to the Board.

Winston Strickland moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the board voted unanimously to deny the application of JCW/barberrenewal.

Winston Strickland moved, Lutha Crump seconded, and the board voted unanimously to approve the application of ECP/barberappr attaching a consent order that the license is placed on probation until October 2, 2007 and the licensee must immediately report any future arrests or convictions to the Board.

Winston Strickland moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the board voted unanimously to approve the application of WBR/barberexam attaching a consent order that the license is placed on probation until December 5, 2009 and the licensee must immediately report any future arrests or convictions to the Board.

Virgle Ergle moved, Lutha Crump seconded, and the board voted unanimously to approve the application of DXL without discipline.

Virgil Ergle moved, Winston seconded, and the board voted unanimously to approve the application of CJB/barberexam attaching a consent order that the license is placed on probation for two years and the licensee must immediately report any future arrests or convictions to the Board.

New Business

Board members discussed the need of additional Regulatory inspectors with the Division Director.

Eleanor Surrency informed the board that Barber and Cosmetology must share responsibility because the impact on staff for one board affects the other board.

Board members agreed to begin a campaign to inform the State Legislators of the critical need of more inspectors by writing letters now, in the fall and in January 2006.

Winston Strickland moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the board voted unanimously to request the Administration to prepare a report of the following:

1. total dollar amounts of citations issued by inspectors
2. the total number of Barber and Cosmetology, Nail, Esthetic Salons in Georgia
3. current salaries/benefits offered to Regulatory Inspectors
4. statistics on the number of Health and Safety violations the Inspectors encounter during inspections

The board instructed the Executive Director to facilitate a joint meeting of the Barber and Cosmetology Boards in the fall.

Winston Strickland moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the board voted unanimously to obtain a training manual for inspectors from NIC and use it as a guide to create a training manual for the board's inspectors.

Board members instructed Ms. Surrency to request representatives from the Testing Department attend the June 2005 Barber Board meeting for the purpose of discussing examinations procedures and the candidate bulletins.

Board members requested Ms. Surrency to order business cards for the members.

The board members voted unanimously to approve actions on applications and requests presented as follows:
