

A meeting of the Georgia State Board of Cosmetology was conducted on Monday – May 23, 2007 at the Professional Licensing Boards Division office site.

Martha Harris established a quorum and called the meeting to order at 9:05 am.

Board members continued to work on revisions to Administrative Rule 130-7-.04.

Eleanor Surrency, Executive Director, assumed the chair so that a quorum could be maintained for voting.

Martha Harris moved, Kay Kendrick seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to enter into Executive Session in accordance with O.C.G.A § 43-1-2(k) and 43-1-9(h) to deliberate on applications, enforcement matters and to review information on applications and investigate reports. Voting in favor of the motion were **John Siggers, Cynthia Stein, and Betty Carlisle**.

The Board concluded Executive Session in order to vote on these matters and to continue public session.

Martha Harris motioned, Kay Kendrick seconded, and the Board voted unanimously that the Board could not make a decision on the application of JDH/MASCOS/RECIP/UK until applicant submits proof of immigration status or green card to work.

Kay Kendrick moved, Cynthia Stein seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to deny the request of RF/MASCOS to waive the reinstatement fee.

Martha Harris moved, Cynthia Stein seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to deny the application of TTT/NT/RECIP./BC but approved to sit for the exam.

Martha Harris moved, Cynthia Stein seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to request from JV/MAS/RECIP/Korea verification of high school education diploma or GED to complete application for review.

Kay Kendrick moved, John Siggers seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to deny the request to release information on TH/MASCOS.

Martha Harris moved, Betty Carlisle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to deny the request of TH/NT to test with DL Roope, Inc. without a fee. Applicant must submit new application along with the fee.

Kay Kendrick moved, Betty Carlisle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to require LA/MASCOS to pay new fee to sit for exam with DL Roope, Inc. Applicant current score is null and void.

Kay Kendrick moved, Betty Carlisle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to require YC/MASCOS to pay new fee to sit for exam with DL Roope, Inc. Applicant current score is null and void.

New Business

Kay Kendrick moved, Betty Carlisle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to adopt a policy that any exam candidate caught cheating, as documented by the provider incident report, must reapply and retake the exam to apply for licensure with the Board. The exam score for the exam in which the candidate was reported cheating will be null and void by the Board office. The policy is effective and retroactive to January 01, 2007.

Martha Harris moved, Kay Kendrick seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to have a conference call with DL Roope, Inc. at the June 06, 2007 Board meeting.
