Business Regulation and Inspection Report

The Business Regulation and Inspection report included the following:

Virgil Ergle moved, Lutha Crump seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to enter Executive Session in accordance with O.C.G.A. χ 43-1-2(k) and 43-1-9(h) to deliberate on applications and enforcement matters and to receive information on applications and investigative reports. Voting in favor of the motion were, David Jones, and Charles Manning.

The Board concluded Executive Session in order to vote on these matters and to continue with public session.

David Jones moved, Virgil Ergle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to table the application of LLK, Jr./MB requesting applicant appear at the August 20, 2007 meeting.

Charles Manning moved, David Jones seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to table the application of SJS/MB requesting applicant appear at the August 20, 2007 meeting.

David Jones moved, Virgil Ergle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to deny the application of GC/BAPP based on the authority given the board in O.C. G. A § 43-1-19.
