Martha Harris called the meeting to order at 9:10 after establishing a quorum.

Wanda Brooks moved, Kay Kendrick seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes from the January 9, 2008 meeting.

Executive Director Report

Eleanor Surrency's report included the following:

1. Report of License Suspensions or Denials:

Pursuant to request from the Department of Human Resources (DHR) and the Georgia Higher Education Assistance Corporation (GHEAC), **Michelle Turley moved, Betty Carlisle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously** that the Board suspends or denies the following licenses/applications to practice for failure to repay a student loan or child support obligation and further move that this suspension/denial will cease upon receipt by the Joint Secretary/Division Director of a "Notice of Release" from the Department of Human Resources (DHR) or the Georgia Higher Education Assistance Corporation (GHEAC):

Kay Kendrick moved, Wanda Brooks seconded and the Board voted unanimously to request a review of all salons/shops that include the word “Barber” in the name and to establish a policy that Cosmetology salon/shop names shall not include the word Barber.

John Siggers moved, Cynthia Stein seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to ratify the report of Consent Agreements signed on behalf of the Chairperson as follows:

The Legal Services Attorneys briefly reviewed the General Provisions list of various sanctions that the Boards may utilize when disciplining an applicant or licensee.

The Assistant Attorney General submitted a Status and Activity Report for Cosmetology Citation cases which were sent to the Attorney General's office for prosecution. **Kay Kendrick moved, Evelyn Reid seconded, and the Board voted unanimously** to officially close the cases indicated in the report as closed.

Michelle Turley moved, John Siggers seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to accept 1855 of the apprentice hours submitted by K'HU/coa and approve a one time renewal of the license for a period of two years to allow the licensee to complete the remaining hours required for examination.

Kay Kendrick moved, Wanda Brooks seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to invite the owner of BWbA/cosa to appear at the March 2008 Board meeting to discuss the services rendered at the owner's salons.

John Siggers moved, Evelyn Reid seconded, and the Board voted by majority to accept an application from JPM/mascos for reinstatement of license.

Kay Kendrick moved, Wanda Brooks seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to require a consent agreement that the license of **SAW/CO** is placed on probation until Oct. 18, 2011 and the licensee must immediately report any future arrests, or convictions to the Board; that upon receipt of the signed, docketed consent agreement the application be issued.

Kay Kendrick moved, Betty Carlisle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to require a consent agreement that the license of **JAG/NTA** is placed on probation until March 28, 2010 and the licensee must immediately report any future arrests, or convictions to the Board; that upon receipt of the signed, docketed consent agreement the application be issued.

Betty Carlisle moved, Evelyn Reid seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to require a consent agreement that the license of **SH/COA** is placed on probation until March 3, 2010 and the licensee must immediately report any future arrests, or convictions to the Board; that upon receipt of the signed, docketed consent agreement the application be issued.

Wanda Brooks moved, Betty Carlisle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to require a consent agreement that the license of **MM/COreinst** is placed on probation until November 2, 2010 and the licensee must immediately report any future arrests, or convictions to the Board; that upon receipt of the signed, docketed consent agreement the application be issued.

Betty Carlisle moved, Wanda Brooks seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve the application of **KLG/COrecip** without discipline.

Wanda Brooks moved, Michelle Turley seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to require a consent agreement that the license of **USC/COSA** is placed on probation until January 19, 2017 and the licensee must immediately report any future arrests, or convictions to the Board; that upon receipt of the signed, docketed consent agreement the application be issued.

Kay Kendrick moved, Betty Carlisle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve the license of **OHS/COSA** without discipline.

John Siggers moved, Cynthia Stein seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to ratify the administratively processed Consent Orders of **Marcus Blades d/b/a Blades Salon and Michele A Perkins**.

Betty Carlisle moved, Evelyn Reid seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve the application of **C-JGA/hdcoa** without discipline.

Betty Carlisle moved, Michelle Turley seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to require a consent agreement that the license of **GTS/COSA** is placed on probation until July 6, 2016 and the licensee must immediately report any future arrests, or

convictions to the Board; that upon receipt of the signed, docketed consent agreement the application be issued.

Wanda Brooks moved, Cynthia Stein seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve the license of **JLM/CO** without discipline.

Wanda Brooks moved, Evelyn Reid seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to require a consent agreement that the license of **ALY/CO** is placed on probation until September 12, 2012 and the licensee must immediately report any future arrests, or convictions to the Board; that upon receipt of the signed, docketed consent agreement the application be issued.

Kay Kendrick moved, Betty Carlisle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to table a decision on the license of **EBS/BSH** and request research as to the type of salon is applied for.

John Siggers moved, Cynthia Stein seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve the signed consent agreement of **LAJ**.

Kay Kendrick moved, Betty Carlisle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to table a decision on the application of **JB&BS/COSA** until additional correspondence is received from applicant.

Michelle Turley moved, John Siggers seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to accept 1855 of the hours submitted by **KU/COA** and approve renewal of the apprentice license for a period of two years to allow the apprentice to complete the remaining hours required for examination.

Kay Kendrick moved, Wanda Brooks seconded and the Board voted unanimously to invite the owner of **BWbyA** to appear at the March 2008 Cos Bd meeting for discussion of the services rendered at these salon locations.

Michelle Turley moved, Evelyn Reid seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to close Enforcement case #COSO50987 upon the recommendation of the Enforcement Agent.

OLD BUSINESS

Kay Kendrick moved, Cynthia Stein seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to establish a policy that valid /current **federal** military Photo ID cards and valid/current State **Drivers License with** Photo **or State** ID cards from **bordering** States of Alabama, Florida, Tennessee, South Carolina, and North Carolina are acceptable forms of identification for examination candidates **with DL Roope**.

Kay Kendrick moved, Michelle Turley seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to establish a policy to exempt inmates from providing picture ID at exams and require

prison guards who are escorting inmates for examination to provide the ID# for each inmate to enter the examination, effective March 2008.

Kay Kendrick moved, Michelle Turley seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to seek the Attorney General's authorities on revisions to Administrative Rule 130-4-.01.

NEW BUSINESS

Wanda Brooks moved, Evelyn Reid seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to establish a policy that requires hand sanitizers at each work station in salons and schools.

Evelyn Reid moved, Kay Kendrick seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to recommend that PBC CONCEPT/Hennie De Wet submit correspondence regarding class three laser treatments to the Medical Board because the technique is out of the scope of practice under the Cosmetology Board's authority.

The Board instructed the Administrative staff to inform an inquirer that a master cosmetology or esthetician license is required to provide the service of eyelash extensions.

Kay Kendrick moved, Betty Carlisle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to direct the Administrative staff and the Attorney General's office to explore the option of the Board conducting hearings on past due citation cases.

The Board directed the Ms. Surrency to invite the Executive Director of the Used Car Dealers Board to the March 2008 Board meeting for an assessment of the procedure because his Board is currently conducting its citation hearings.

Kay Kendrick moved, John Siggers seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve the following actions on applications, request, etc:
