4. Request Board Establish Policy:

Lorena Barrios moved, Virgil Ergle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to establish a policy that master barbers whose licenses are on probation may not train barber apprentices.

Virgil Ergle moved, Lutha Crump seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to establish a policy that effective April 21, 2008 an active license from the original state of licensure of an endorsement applicant is not required, the applicant must provide certification of an active license in a state/country that the Board reciprocates with, and a certification of licensure from each state that the applicant held license.

Eleanor Surrency read the Cease and Desist Policy, which states: **It is the policy of the Georgia State Board of Barbers to accept all Voluntary Cease and Desist Orders upon receipt in the Board office and authorize the president/chairperson or his or her designee to execute the Order and to authorize the Orders to be docketed and served. It is the intent of the Board that the Orders will be in effect upon docketing. The Georgia State Board of Barbers will ratify the docketed Cease and Desist Orders at its next meeting after the date of docketing and include a list of the approved Orders in the board minutes.**

Lorena Barrios moved, Charles Manning seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to adopt the Cease and Desist orders policy read by Eleanor Surrency.

Assistant Attorney General's Presentations

Virgil Ergle moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to enter Executive Session in accordance with O.C.G.A. χ 43-1-2(k) and 43-1-9(h) to deliberate on applications and enforcement matters and to receive information on applications and investigative reports. Voting in favor of the motion were, Charles Manning, Lutha Crump, Virgil Ergle and Lorena Barrios.

The Board concluded Executive Session in order to vote on these matters and to continue with public session.

Lorena Barrios moved, Virgil Ergle seconded, and the Board voted to deny the application of CDC/master barber-initial citing O.C.G.A § 43-1-19 as its authority to deny.

Virgil Ergle moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve the application attaching a consent order requiring that the license of PLH/master barber is placed on probation until June 2, 2014 and requiring that the applicant immediately report any future arrests or convictions to the Board.

Lorena Barrios moved, Virgil Ergle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to require CES,III/barber apprentice to get another master barber who is not on probation to supervise his training, and issue the license.

Charles Manning moved, Lorena Barrios seconded and the Board voted unanimously to extend the probation of CBW/barber until 2/20/2009.

Lorena Barrios moved, Charles Manning seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to deny the application of GBSS/Renewal, and to request a statement from her probation officer.

Lorena Barrios moved, Lutha Crump seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to ratify the administratively processed agreements/orders for Shawn Graves.

Charles Manning moved Lorena Barrios seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to deny apprentice license to ALW/barber apprentice citing O.C.G.A § 43-1-19 as its authority to deny.

Virgil Ergle moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to deny the renewal application of TLD/Barber Apprentice citing O.C.G.A § 43-1-19 as its authority to deny.

Virgil Ergle moved, Lutha Crump seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve the application attaching a consent order requiring that the license of SBS/master barber is placed on probation until April 2009 and requiring that the applicant immediately report any future arrests or convictions to the Board.

Virgil Ergle moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve the application attaching a consent order requiring that the license of R&SBS /shop is placed on probation until March 14, 2010, and requiring that the applicant immediately report any future arrests or convictions to the Board.

Charles Manning moved, Lutha Crump seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve renewal of barber apprentice license for MB/Barber Apprentice without discipline.

Charles Manning moved, Virgil Ergle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to deny application of PBJ/master barber citing O.C.G.A § 43-1-19 as its authority to deny.

Virgil Ergle moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to deny the application of REB/master barber citing O.C.G.A § 43-1-19 as its authority to deny.

Lorena Barrios moved, Charles Manning seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve the following administratively processed consent agreements:

- a. John Willis Scott – consent agreement for licensure
- b. Keynon Cardez Samuels – consent agreement for licensure
- c. Thomas Henry Ketch, III – consent agreement for renewal

Virgil Ergle moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to deny and close the files for the following applications.

Virgil Ergle moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to deny waiving reinstatement fee for JH/barber.

Lutha Crump moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve endorsement for KPD/master barber.

Lorena Barrios moved, Virgil Ergle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to deny endorsement for PH/master barber pending more documentation from Louisiana State Board. Barber Board staff was asked to find out exactly what are the crossover requirements for Cosmetologists to receive a Barber license in Louisiana.

Lorena Barrios moved, Virgil Ergle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve endorsement for AM/master barber.

Lorena Barrios moved, Virgil Ergle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to invite DKF apprentice to appear before the cognizant committee to appeal the Board's previous decision to deny licensure.

Lorena Barrios moved, Virgil Ergle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to invite ML/apprentice to appear before the cognizant committee to appeal the Board's previous decision to deny licensure.

The Board concluded Executive Session in order to vote on these matters and to continue with public session.

Virgil Ergle moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve the application of CFA/shop attaching a consent agreement that the license is placed on probation until April 2019 and the licensee must immediately report any future arrests or convictions to the Board.

Virgil Ergle moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to uphold the decision to deny licensure to ABC barber apprentice.

Lorena Barrios moved, Lutha Crump seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve the application of RL/master barber attaching a consent agreement that the license is placed on probation until 11/3/2017 and requiring that the licensee immediately report any future arrests or convictions to the Board.

Virgil Ergle moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve the application of EBS&BS/shop attaching a consent agreement that the license is placed on probation until April 2014 and the licensee must immediately report any future arrests or convictions to the Board.

Virgil Ergle moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to uphold the decision to deny licensure to AS,II/barber and require that the master barber ALW/master appear at the June 30, 2008 Board meeting regarding the submission of apprentice hours.

Virgil Ergle moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve the application of GA/master barber endorsement, attaching a consent agreement that the license is placed on probation until April 2019 and the licensee must immediately report any future arrests or convictions to the Board.

Mobile Salon discussion. Mr. Jones instructed the administrative staff to prepare proposed revisions to Administrative Rule 70-2-.08 and 70-4-.01 to include language regarding mobile salons. The proposed rule revisions should state that there need to be rules in place to include requirements that mobile salons submit the Vin# of the mobile unit and that the mobile unit is equipped with a GPS system.
