Kay Kendrick moved, Cynthia Stein seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to enter Executive Session in accordance with O.C.G.A. 43-1-2(k) and 43-1-9(h) to deliberate on information received during the Hearings. Voting in favor of the motion were, Wanda Brooks, Betty Carlisle, Evelyn Reid, Kay Kendrick, and Cynthia Stein.

The Board concluded Executive Session in order to vote on these matters and to continue with public session.

Cynthia Stein moved, Betty Carlisle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to uphold the citation of Beauty Center COSA031560 – McDonough Georgia and allow 30 days from the date of docketing of the final decision for payment in full.

Cynthia Stein moved, Betty Carlisle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to reschedule one more citation hearing for CB /master because she notified the Board that she was unable to attend the 5-19-08 hearing.

Kay Kendrick moved, Cynthia Stein seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to dismiss one of the unlicensed practice violations for Great Clips COSA025014 – Griffin, Georgia because Rebecca Ann Buck had created and used a fraudulent license without the knowledge of the salon owner and to uphold fines assessed for one other unlicensed practitioner thus reducing the citation amount to \$500 and allowing 30 days from date of docketing of the final decision for payment in full.

Kay Kendrick moved, Betty Carlisle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to uphold the citation of Hair By th COSA035624 – Jonesboro, Georgia and allow 30 days from date of docketing of the final decision for payment in full.

Kay Kendrick moved, Cynthia Stein seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to reduce the citation amount for Donna Heinz CO003006 – Decatur, Georgia from \$500 to \$100 and allow 30 days from date of docketing of the final decision for payment in full.

Kay Kendrick moved, Cynthia Stein seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to reduce the citation amount Innervision Hair COSA027018 – Riverdale, Georgia from \$500 to \$300 and allow 30 days from date of docketing of final decision for payment in full.

Cynthia Stein moved, Betty Carlisle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to uphold the citation of Just For U COSA032585 – Columbus, Georgia allowing 30 days from date of docketing of the final decision for payment in full

K J D/master–did not appear for hearing but sent correspondence requesting time to pay citation. **Cynthia Stein moved, Kay Kendrick seconded, and the Board voted unanimously** to allow the owner 30 days from hearing date to pay the citation in full and instructed the administrative staff to send notification of the decision to the licensee.

Kay Kendrick moved, Wanda Brooks seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to dismiss the citation Midwest Hair Studio Salon COSA036009 – Jonesboro, Georgia without prejudice because the shop is closed and the owner's Barber license is lapsed and instructed the administrative staff to send notification to shop owner that the license is no longer valid and cannot be reinstated.

Cynthia Stein moved, Wanda Brooks seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to dismiss the citation of Modern Nails & Day Spa Salon COSA038917 – Locust Grove, Georgia without prejudice and to issue another license without fee because the incorrect salon address was due to administrative error and to issue another license without fee.

Kay Kendrick moved, Evelyn Reid seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to allow SYT/master 30 days to pay the citation in full and if the licensee fails to pay reschedule the citation hearing.

The owner of TBS/salon did not appear for hearing. **Betty Carlisle moved, Cynthia Stein seconded, and the Board voted unanimously** to reschedule the hearing.

Kay Kendrick moved, Evelyn Reid seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to reduce the citation amount of His N Hers World of Hair Beauty COSA002216 – Forsyth, Georgia from \$500 to \$250 allowing 30 days from date of docketing of the final decision for payment in full.

Kay Kendrick moved, Wanda Brooks seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to reduce the citation amount of A Cut Above Beauty Salon COSA022225 – Forsyth, Georgia from \$500 to \$250 and allow 30 days from docketing of the final decision for payment in full.

Kay Kendrick moved, Evelyn Reid seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to instruct the Executive Director invite the Georgia Department of Technical and Adult Education's Technical Education Program Coordinator to attend a Cosmetology Board meeting in the near future to discuss sanitation updates for the Cosmetology Continuing Education Curriculum.
