3. Ms. Surrency discussed the Counts by Profession report, which was included in the packets.
4. Ms. Surrency also discussed our budget situation relating to travel expenses for conferences.
5. Ms. Surrency discussed adding a date for Barber Instructor exams. **Lorena Barrios moved, Charles Manning seconded, and the Board voted unanimously** to request permission to add November 17, 2008 as an exam date.
6. Ms. Surrency presented a plan to create three (3) teams of cognizant for the purpose of hearing appeal cases from 1:15 p.m. until 2:00 p.m. during the scheduled Barber Board meetings. **Lutha Crump moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the Board voted unanimously** to begin this process at the October 27, 2008 Board meeting.

The Board discussed the concerns they had regarding Inspections with Ms. Shawn LaGrua. Ms. LaGrua agreed that the Board should have input in Inspector training. She further stated that it is the Board's discretion at a citation hearing to uphold, reduce or dismiss the citation. The citation sheet was discussed. The Board members will look at areas that may need revision.

Executive Session:

Winston Strickland moved, Lorena Barrios seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to enter Executive Session in accordance with O.C.G.A. χ 43-1-2(k) and 43-1-9(h) to deliberate on applications and enforcement matters and to receive information on applications and investigative reports. Voting in favor of the motion were, Charles Manning, Lutha Crump, Virgil Ergle, Winston Strickland, Lorena Barrios, and David Jones.

Lorena Barrios moved, Lutha Crump seconded, and the Board concluded Executive Session in order to vote on these matters and to continue with public session.
