David Jones, Chairperson established that a quorum was present. The meeting was called to order at 9:12 a.m.

Virgil Ergle made a motion, Lutha Crump seconded and the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the April 13, 2009 meeting.

Executive Director's Report

Lisa Durden, Executive Director gave the following report:

- Report of license suspension, denials, release:

Pursuant to request from the Department of Human Resources (DHR) and the Georgia Higher Education Assistance Corporation (GHEAC), the Board was requested to deny the application or suspend the license of the following applicants/licensees to practice for failure to repay a student loan or child support obligation and further move that this suspension/denial will cease upon receipt by the Joint Secretary/Division Director of a "Notice of Release" from the Department of Human Resources (DHR) or the Georgia Higher Education Assistance Corporation (GHEAC):

Craig Fluck, from the Exam and Development Section, discussed options for scoring the Barber examinations with Board members.

Winston Strickland made a motion, Charles Manning seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to use scale scoring and that a scale score of 70 on both the practical and the written are required for passing.

Winston Strickland made a motion, Charles Manning seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to close the following complaint:

Winston Strickland made a motion, Virgil Ergle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to refer the following licenses to the Attorney General's office for revocation due to unpaid citations:

A motion was made by Winston Strickland, seconded by Virgil Ergle and the Board voted unanimously to enter Executive Session in accordance with O.C.G.A. §43-1-2(k) and 43-1-9(h) to deliberate on applications and enforcement matters and to receive information on applications and information received during the Hearings. Virgil Ergle made a motion, Charles Manning seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve reinstatement of MA, Master Barber.

Winston Strickland made a motion, Virgil Ergle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to deny endorsement of JKS, Master Barber; he may sit for the examination.

Virgil Ergle made a motion, Winston Strickland seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to deny request to accept apprentice hours from March 3, 2009 – April 11, 2009 for TA, Barber Apprentice.

Winston Strickland made a motion, Charles Manning seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve endorsement of BKH, Master Barber if he has been licensed in Florida for the past 10 years. If he has not been licensed for the past 10 years, he may sit for the examination.

Winston Strickland made a motion, Virgil Ergle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve shop application of MK&M under a consent order with a \$500 fine and four years probation.

Winston Strickland made a motion, Virgil Ergle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to approve shop application of R&PB under a consent order with a \$500 fine and four years probation.

Winston Strickland made a motion, Virgil Ergle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to deny endorsement of MCP, Master Barber. He may sit for the examination.

Charles Manning made a motion, Virgil Ergle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to have a committee meeting to discuss bathroom facilities at Barbershops. Winston Strickland and David Jones will comprise that committee and will work with the Board's attorney regarding this matter.
