- Executive Director, Lisa Durden presented the D L Roope pass fail report to the Board members. The Board requested approval for one Board member to travel to test sites as needed and to be reimbursed for travel to those examinations. Mr. Strickland and Mr. Jones stated the Board would like to do this until they are satisfied with the exam that is being conducted. Ms. Durden explained that any travel reimbursement requests would have to pre-approved by the Division Director. Ms. Durden further explained that given the current economic situation, she could not say whether or not the request would be approved. Mr. Strickland stated that the he thought the Board's contract with DL Roope gave them the authority to go to the examinations. Ms. Durden explained that the contract does allow board members to visit the exam sites; however, travel to the sites would have to be pre-approved if the Board member would like to be reimbursed. Mr. Strickland asked for clarification from the board attorney concerning the board's authority to conduct travel based on Georgia law.
