Slatz Gaines recommended that identification cards be issued to Board members. Lisa Durden will check into this.

Cynthia Stein made a motion, Betty Carlisle seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to propose the following Legislative changes:

1. School Hours - School keeps records for five years and provides students with their transcripts, The Board doesn't maintain school records.
2. Exam Scores– Maintain records for two years. Pass both parts within two years or retake both parts.
3. Apprentice License – Four-year apprentice license. (Must pass examination within two years.)
4. Apprentice Hours – Maximum of twelve hours per day (clock or credit).
5. Foreign educated applicants – Require credentials evaluation from a Board approved credentials evaluation provider.
6. Change definitions for cosmetology and esthetics as follows:

43-10-1 Definitions

5(D) Hair removal by threading, waxing, stimulating, cleansing, or beautifying the face, neck, arms or legs of a person by any method with the aid of the hands or any mechanical or electrical apparatus or by the use of a cosmetic preparation.

(9) "Nail Technician" means a person who for compensation, trims, files, shapes, decorates, applies sculptured or otherwise artificial nails, or in any way cares for the hands, arms, legs and feet of another person.

7. Health and Safety continuing education – Change wording to Curriculum developed by the Cosmetology Board – take out Department of Technical and Adult Education.

No further business was discussed and the meeting adjourned at 3:15 pm.
