Kimberly Green wrote a letter to the Board with several questions about the scope of practice for weaving. The Board directed staff to send her a letter indicating that the Board cannot give her legal advice.

Applicant T.T.T.T. submitted a request that the credentialing paperwork from California University be considered to verify his proof of high school diploma. The Board asked staff to find out if this is a recognized credentialing service. If so, this can be accepted.

The Board recommended to uphold their previous decision to deny her reciprocity application; further emphasizing that she go to school and achieve the require hours of instructors training and then sit for instructors exam.

**E.B.S.** (Salon Application) – applicant recieved a C&D, but shop has already paid \$750. The Board recommended approving the application.

**M.N.P.** (Nail Tech Apprentice application) – application received a C&D, but salon has paid fine in full. The Board recommended approving the application.

**Imagine That Beauty Salon** requested that the probation be lifted from license. The Board recommended denying request stating that probation period must be completed.

**Danielle S. Ashbourne, ES002657, ESI-000071** requested a CE waiver for both licenses due to hardship. The Board recommended to waive the CE for the esthician license but to deny CE waiver request for the instructor license.

**Angela Smith** submitted a letter of appeal asking the Board to reconsider their decision to require her to complete formal training for an instructor's license. The Board recommended upholding its previous decision to require her to complete the instructor training program.

**Mac & Mia Haircutters Bty Salon, COSA004398** requested that the probation sanction be lifted from the Consent Order. The Board recommended to deny the request to lift the probation sanction from the Consent Order.

**Valentina B. Robinson, COI-001024** requested a CE waiver due to hardship. The Board recommended to deny the CE Instructor waiver request.
