Executive Director, Eric Lacefield reminded the Board that House Bill 87, Law 50-34-1 regarding the requirement of all licensees to verify citizenship upon renewal of license goes into effect January 1, 2012. He again reminded the Board that every renewal application must be administratively processed which make take up to 90 days to process the renewal. He further encouraged the Board to spread the word to renew prior to January 1, 2012.
