Lynn Thomas, PSI Chief Board Examiner, submitted a memorandum notifying the Board of an insert that has been added to the Georgia Candidate Information Bulletin. The Board reviewed the insert and stated they do not support the insert as is. The Board requested the insert be revised to 1 hour arrival time prior examination, opposing the 30 minute arrival as currently stated on the bulletin. Additionally, the Board requested that the Candidate plus one guest be allowed to the test center, inside the building and/or the building's property; opposing the policy that person(s) accompanying the Candidate may not wait in the test center, inside the building, or on the building's property.

Zakia Ceaser submitted an inquiry to the Board seeking clarity on the laws and rules surrounding spa parties for children. The Board advised that they do not interpret the law and she should seek private counsel for clarification on the Cosmetology Board laws and rules.

Phuc T. Nguyen, owner of ABC Travel & Income Tax LLC and Ngoc Dieu Thi Vo both requested to be added to the Board's list of approved translators. The Board denied their request and advised that Phuc Nguyen and Ngoc Dieu Thi Vo be informed of Board Policy #7 which states "All translators must be certified or be an approved translator by another state or government entity to be accepted for translation for cosmetology."

The Board held a public hearing regarding the proposed amendments to the Board Rule; Rule 130-4-.01 Facilities. The Board heard statements from Tamera Johnson and Wanda Truesdale.

Following these public comments Betty Carlisle made a motion to adopt the proposed amendments to Board Rule; Rule 130-4-.01 Facilities; Katie Glover seconded the motion, and the Board voted unanimously in favor to adopt the amended rule as follows:

**GEORGIA STATE BOARD OF COSMETOLOGY RULES**

**CHAPTER 130-4 RULE 130-4.01 FACILITIES**

NOTE: Struck through text will be deleted. Underlined text will be added.

**130-4-.01 Facilities.**

(1) All facilities (salons/shops or schools) wherein cosmetology services are practiced or taught within the State of Georgia must provide suitable quarters equipped to give adequate services, ~~subject to inspection by representatives of the Georgia State Board of Cosmetology.~~ All facilities are subject to inspection by any Board member or inspector, who shall have the power and right to enter into and make reasonable inspection of any facility during regular business hours; and refusal of or failure to permit or cooperate with such reasonable inspection shall subject an individual and/or a facility holding a certificate of registration issued by the Board to sanctions, including revocation of the certificate of registration.

(2) A beauty facility shall have a permanent and definite location in which the cosmetology professions of master cosmetologist, hair designer, nail technician, and/or esthetician, are practiced in accordance with the laws and rules of the Georgia State Board of Cosmetology. All mobile units, including kiosks, carts, mobile homes, trailers, and motor homes, shall not be licensed as salons/shops unless they meet all requirements of the Board and are permanently anchored on the ground with wheels detached.
