The Georgia State Board of Barbers met by conference call on March 30, 2015 at the Professional Licensing Boards, 237 Coliseum Drive, Macon, GA 31217.

Chairperson, David Jones established a quorum was present and called the meeting to order at 9:14 a.m.

EXECUTIVE SESSION:
