Consideration of Board Rule 85-1-.11: Georgia State Champion Rule –

Commissioner Hunnicutt motioned, Commissioner Harris seconded and the board voted to post the rule.

Commissioner Icter went on the record that the proposed rules for professional wrestling did not do enough to protect the wrestlers themselves. Additionally he stated the commission should do everything it can to make the WWE accountable for any rules adopted by the GAEC.

Consideration of Board Rules 85-4-.01: Professional Wrestling Rules –

Commissioner Icter motioned, Commissioner Hunnicutt seconded and the board voted to post the rules.

Board Policy: The Executive Director of the commission, at their discretion, can temporarily approve an event permit as it pertains to rule 85-1-.05(4)(a). Following the temporary approval the event permit will need to be ratified at the next commission meeting to become valid.

Commissioner Hunnicutt made a motion, Commissioner Bloodworth seconded and the Board voted to enter into **Executive Session** in accordance with O.C.G.A §43-1-19(h)(2) and §43-1-2(k) to deliberate on applications and enforcement matters and to receive information on applications, investigative reports, and the Assistant Attorney General's report.
