Chairman J.J. Biello established that a quorum was present and the Georgia Athletic and Entertainment Commission meeting that were scheduled to begin at 11:00 a.m. was called to order at 11:00am a.m.

Motion to Approve the license application for Curt Render. Chairman Biello tables until the end of the meeting to see if Mr. Render shows.

Motion to Approve the license application for Sterling Moore. Chairman Biello tables until the end of the meeting to see if Mr. Moore shows.

Re-Vote on proposed rule change 85-4-.07, contestant's equipment. Commissioner Kiker said that he spoke with Andy Foster, who is in favor of adding in headgear. Vice Chairman Ector makes a motion to approve Rule 85-4-.07 and send this rule to the Attorney General's office and post for 30 days. Commissioner Thompson seconds and the Commission votes 4-0 to post the rule.

Motion to Approve the license application for Sterling Moore. Commissioner Towns makes a motion to approve. Chairman Biello seconds, and the Commission votes 5-0 to approve Mr. Moore for a license.

Discussion on mma.tv with David Oblas. Amateur shows are not always posted on this site, and it is hard to find the correct record for amateur fighters and their correct records. Commissioner Thompson makes a motion to have the Executive Director to discuss with the Attorney General's office what the term verifiable means, and the possibility of matchbooks. Vice Chairman Ector seconds, and the Commission votes 5-0.

Discussion with kickboxing. David Oblas wants to know how the records will be verified and Commissioner Thompson said it is going to be discussed with the Executive Director and the Attorney General's office.

Motion to adjourn. Chairman Biello makes the motion, Vice Chairman Ector seconds and the commission voted 5-0 to adjourn.
