An amateur sanctioning body would need to handle those fights. If a promoter was to put on unsanctioned bouts, he could face criminal charges for unarmed combat.

**Discussion** on Ben Brewer's suspension. Ben Brewer is scheduled to be the main event on the April 8<sup>th</sup> event, however is under a suspension, and would need to have that lifted. Commissioner Thompson is opposed to lifting a fighter's suspension. Chairman Geary and Commissioner Young agree. The suspension is to remain intact and Mr. Brewer will not be allowed to compete on April 8<sup>th</sup>.
