Chairman McMurtrey called the meeting to order at 9:10 a.m.

Mr. Chambers made a motion to approve the minutes from the June 22, 2011 Board meeting as presented. Mr. McMurtrey seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

Executive Session

At 9:37 a.m., Mr. Wommack made a motion to enter into Executive Session in accordance with O.C.G.A.43-1-2(k) and 43-1-19(h) to deliberate on applications and investigative matters and to receive an investigative report. Mr. Bowman seconded the motion. Voting in favor of the motion were those members present who included Board Members - Andy Chambers, Charles McMurtrey, Bruce Bowman, Counte Cooley and Keith Wommack.

Open Session reconvened at 10:00 a.m. with the following Board members present – Andy Chambers, Charles McMurtrey, Keith Wommack, Bruce Bowman, and Counte Cooley.

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The following Staff Members presented reports to the Board:

Mr. Mickler reported on plans for hiring a new Board Support Specialist.

The Assistant Attorney General

The Assistant Attorney General reported on cases received from the Board.

Investigations

Mr. Wommack moved to accept the recommendations regarding investigative cases:

LV100018 – This case involves allegations of unlicensed practice. The Board made a recommendation to obtain a Cease and Desist Order.

LV110018 – This case involves an application for licensure with convictions. The Board made a recommendation to issue the license on probation for 2 renewal cycles in which the licensee must submit a GCIC report semi-annually.

LV110019 – This case involves allegations of unlicensed practices. The Board made a recommendation to close case with no action.

LV120006 – This case involves allegations of unprofessional conduct/ substandard work. The Cognizant made a recommendation to send a certified letter to respondent for letter of explanation.

LV110030 – This case involves allegations of unlicensed practice. The Board made a recommendation to table case for further review by the Cognizant.

LV110039 – This case involves allegations of unlicensed practices. The Board made a recommendation to close case because the Secretary of State's Investigations and the Executive Director indicated that a Low Voltage Contractor's License is not required.

LV110028 - This case involves allegations of unlicensed practices. The Board made a recommendation to close case because the Secretary of State's Investigations and the Executive Director indicated that a Low Voltage Contractor's License is not required.

LV110026 – This case involves allegations of unlicensed practice. Respondent admitted that they were in violation but refused to sign the Cease and Desist Order. Cognizant made a recommendation to refer case to the Attorney General's Office after determining who the officers of the company are.

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LV110023 – This case involves allegations of unlicensed practice. The Board made a recommendation to refer this case to the Attorney General’s Office to obtain a Cease and Desist Order or schedule a hearing.

LV110025 – Allegations of company performing unlicensed practices. The Board made a recommendation to close case.

LV110032 – This case involves allegations of unlicensed practice. The Board made a recommendation to close case due to the Secretary of State’s Investigations report of lack of evidence. Homeowner will not cooperate with Agent and the Agent could not cooperate with respondent.

Robert Lane Underwood, Jr. d/b/a A Tech Communications - The Board made a recommendation to close case.

LV110004 - This case involves allegations of unprofessional conduct. The Board made a recommendation to refer case to the Attorney General’s Office for a Consent Order placing the license on probation for 60 months and assessing a \$1,500.00 fine for 1 violation each of 43-14-6 (4d) engaging in any dishonorable or unethical conduct, and 43-14-6 (4g) performance of any faulty, inadequate, insufficient or unsafe ...likely to endanger life, health or property.

Aaron Lines, Watkinsville - This case involves allegations of a licensee acting as a qualifying license holder for a company while being employed full time elsewhere. The Board made a recommendation to accept the Consent Order placing the license on probation for 24 months, assessing a \$500.00 fine and closing case.

Mr. McMurtrey seconded. The motion carried unanimously.
