Chairman McMurtrey called the meeting to order at 9:03 a.m.

Mr. Wommack made a motion to approve the minutes from the February 29, 2012 Board meeting as presented. Mr. Cooley seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

Executive Session

At 9:05 a.m., Mr. Cooley made a motion to enter into Executive Session in accordance with O.C.G.A.43-1-2(k) and 43-1-19(h) to deliberate on applications and investigative matters and to receive an investigative report. Mr. Wommack seconded the motion. Voting in favor of the motion were those members present who included Board Chairman Charles McMurtrey, Counte Cooley, Keith Wommack, and Bruce Bowman.

Executive Director's Report

Mr. Mickler introduced the new Licensing Analyst, Jeanette Leeks.

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Mr. Cooley moved to accept the recommendations regarding investigative cases:

Board Office

LV120019 – This case involves allegations and substantiation of respondent failing to report incarceration and falsifying renewal coupon. The Board made a recommendation to refer this case to the Attorney General's Office for revocation of LVU license.

Investigations

LV090025 - This case involves allegations of unlicensed practice. As to Respondent 2, the Board made a recommendation to close with no action.

James Crumbley, Lawrenceville – This case involves allegations of unlicensed practice. The Board made a recommendation to accept the Cease and Desist Order and close case.

LV110017 – This case involves allegations of unlicensed practice. The Board made a recommendation to close due to no violations.

LV110033 - This case involves allegations of unlicensed practice. The Board made a recommendation to close due to no violations.

LV120007 - This case involves allegations of unlicensed practice. The Board made a recommendation to close with no action.

Craig L. Davis, Warner Robins - This case involves allegations of unlicensed practice. The Board made a recommendation to accept the Cease and Desist Order and close case.

Mr. Wommack seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

Applications:

The Board reviewed a list of applicants that have been previously reviewed and approved. Mr. Wommack moved. Mr. Cooley seconded and the division voted to approve the examination results and ratify 12 Alarm, 9 Telecommunication, 6 General, 25 Unrestricted licenses issued from February 29, 2012 - June 26, 2012.

Assistant Attorney General

The Assistant Attorney General reported on cases received from the Board:

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Lany Rucker d/b/a Rucker Fence Co., Dawsonville – This case involves allegations of unlicensed practice. The Board made a recommendation to accept the Cease and Desist Order and close case.

Mr. Wommack moved to accept the Assistant Attorney General’s report. Mr. Cooley second. The motion carried unanimously.

Other Business:

The Board discussed Continuing Education requirements. The Board made a recommendation to move forward with the necessary steps to amend the Georgia Law and the Board Rules to provide for Continuing Education, the definitions of Low Voltage Contractors, and clarification of branch office and supervision requirements.

There being no further business, at 10:13 a.m., Mr. Wommack moved to adjourn. Mr. Bowman seconded. The motion carried unanimously.
