Chairman McMurtrey called the meeting to order at 9:07 a.m.

Mr. Zimler made a motion to approve the Open Session minutes from the October 2, 2013 meeting, the November 4, 2013 teleconference, the November 22, 2013 teleconference and the January 27, 2014 teleconference as presented. Mr. Cooley seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

**Executive Session**

At 9:09 a.m., Mr. Cooley made a motion to enter into Executive Session in accordance with O.C.G.A.43-1-2(k) and 43-1-19(h) to deliberate on applications and investigative matters and to receive an investigative report. 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**Executive Session Minutes:**

Mr. Bowman made a motion to approve the Executive Session minutes from the October 2, 2013 meeting and the November 4, 2014 teleconference meeting as presented. Mr. Lochlear seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

**Applications:**

The Board reviewed a list of applicants that have been previously reviewed and approved. Mr. Cooley moved. Mr. Bowman seconded and the division voted to approve the examination results and ratify 17 Alarm, 2 General, 4 Telecommunication and 24 Unrestricted licenses issued from October 2, 2013 – April 15, 2014.

**LV140014-** Close and refer to Electrical Board.

**LVA205990- Donald Shane Dawson-** Approved request to terminate probation status.

**LV140009- Donald Shane Dawson** – Accept consent order for Low Voltage Alarm licensure suspending the license for 12 months, but can request lifting suspension after 6 months, then place license on probation for 24 months.

**LV140006-** Close due to no violations.

**LV130020- Casey Kicklighter, Tifton-** Accept Cease & Desist and close.

**LV140008-** Refer to Attorney General to obtain Cease & Desist or schedule hearing.

**LV140011-** Close due to no violations.

**Assistant Attorney General:**

**LV130007-** Accept motion to accept the Voluntary Dismissal without Prejudice to end the hearing process.

**Other Business**

The Board recommended tabling the Correspondence Discussion with Patrick Crouch and Keith Segars for further information from Helen, GA.

The Board discussed scheduling the review of applications process with new members on the same day of the hearing.
