Correspondence:

The Board reviewed and discussed the correspondence. The correspondence included the following: (A) Wiring systems of 50 volts or less and control circuits directly associated therewith; Does this mean all voltages AC and DC? and does this mean that the installation is to be performed under the supervision of low voltage license holder? Can any portion of the work be performed by someone having a Class 2 Unrestricted license?

(B) Wiring systems having a voltage in excess of 50 volts, provided such systems consist solely of power limited circuits meeting the definition of a Class II and Class III wiring system as defined in Article 725 of the National Electrical Code; If the voltages are in excess of 50V can the work be performed by someone holding a Class 2 Unrestricted License? AC and DC .

A motion was made by Cooley, seconded by Zimler and the Board voted to respond as follows: (A) It is the position of the Board that wiring systems of 50 volts or less and control circuits directly associated therewith includes all voltages AC and DC, and individuals installing said systems must be supervised by a licensed low voltage contractor. No portion of this work can be performed by someone other than a licensed low voltage contractor or employee. (B) Please comply with the 1984 Attorney General Opinion relating to this issue. None opposed, motion carried.

Discussion:

The Board reviewed House Bill 821, House Bill 952, and Senate Bill 367 from the 2016 Legislative Session that were passed and have been signed into law.

Cooley gave an overview of the results of House Bill 593 from the 2016 Legislative Session. The bill did not pass, but will be presented again next session in 2017.

A motion was made by Cooley, seconded by Bowman, and the Board voted to provide another letter of support for House Bill 593 to be sent to Representative Lee Hawkins and Senator Butch Miller. None opposed, motion carried.

Executive Session:

At 11:12 a.m. a motion was made by Cooley, seconded by Bowman, and the Board voted to enter into Executive Session in accordance with O.C.G.A. §§ 43-1-2(k), 43-1-19(h), and 50-14-2(1). None opposed, motion carried.
