

**GEORGIA BOARD OF MASSAGE THERAPY
MINUTES OF BOARD MEETING
November 15, 2012**

The Georgia Board of Massage Therapy Public Hearings before the Board, and the scheduled Board meeting, were held Thursday, November 15, 2012, in The Professional Licensing Boards Division offices located at 237 Coliseum Drive, Macon, Georgia.

Ms. Johnson established that a quorum of the Board was present and called the Board Hearings to order at 9:32 a.m.

Ms. Lescak motioned, Mr. Seagraves seconded and the Board voted that the respondent was adequately served with notice of today's hearing; that the state has presented sufficient evidence of unlicensed practice in the state of Georgia and based on this evidence, orders the respondent to Cease and Desist from unlicensed practice in the state of Georgia.

In addition, Ms. Lescak motioned, Mr. Seagraves seconded to refer the matter to the Attorney General's office for preparation and service of a Voluntary Cease and Desist Board Order and a \$1000 fine (two occurrences of unlicensed practice @ \$500 each). None opposed, motions carried.

In addition, Ms. Lescak motioned, Mr. Seagraves seconded to accept a Voluntary Cease and Desist Board Order and a \$500 fine. None opposed, motions carried.

Ms. Lescak motioned, and Mr. Seagraves seconded, and the Board voted to enter into Executive Session in accordance with O.C.G.A § 43-1-19 (h)(2) & (4) to deliberate of the matters presented in today's hearings Voting in favor of the motion were those present who included Board members Johnson, Lescak, Seagraves, and Clay.

Correspondences:

Board Chair Report:

1. Ms. Johnson notified the Board that the state of Florida had suspended over 200 massage therapist licenses in that state for obtaining a license with a fraudulent Florida school transcript. So far, approximately 20 individuals listed in the Florida media report also hold Georgia licenses. The staff and Chair will verify the identity and transcripts of the Georgia licensees and request the Board vote next scheduled meeting to pursue disciplinary actions against the identified licensees.
2. CEU Requirements; CPR – Should the Board accept as part of the "hands on" requirement for continuing education hours for renewals? Due to time constraints, these and other discussion items to be tabled until tomorrow's scheduled meeting date, November 16, 2012. NCBTMB Correspondence discussion also tabled.

Ms. Lescak motioned, Mr. Seagraves seconded, and the Board voted to accept the Board Chair report as presented. None opposed, motion carried.
