

**MINUTES OF THE
Georgia State Board of Examiners for Podiatry

EXECUTIVE SESSION

RULE REVISIONS

Christoph C. Zenker, Board Chairman, presented the following Rule for Adoption and the Board voted that the formulation and adoption of this rule does not impose excessive regulatory cost on any licensee, and any cost to comply with the proposed rule cannot be reduced by a less expensive alternative that fully accomplishes the objectives of the statutory provisions. The formulation and adoption of this rule will impact every licensee in the same manner and each licensee is independently licensed, owned, and operated and dominant in the field of Podiatry.

Rule 500-2-.01(a)(4)(iii) Qualifications for Examination and Licensure.

Christoph Zenker made a motion to approve for adoption. William Turner seconded the motion. The motion carried with Zenker, Turner, Jokhai, and Sanders voting in favor of adopting the proposed rule change.

There being no further business, motion Zenker, seconded Turner, and motion carried to adjourn meeting at 10:40 a.m.
