Georgia Board of Private Detective and Security Agencies  
Wednesday, February 17, 2006

### **Minutes Approved at the February 23, 2006 Meeting**

The Georgia Board of Private Detective and Security Agencies held a conference call meeting on February 17, 2006 at 237 Coliseum Drive, Macon, Georgia. Mr. John Villines, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 10:15 a.m.

A quorum was established with members present being: John Villines, Chairman, Robert Warner, Board Member, Woodrow Blue, Board Member, and Vernon Keenan, Board Member.

Others present were: Steve Lindsey, Executive Director and Ajay Gohil, Assistant Attorney General.

#### **Executive Session:**

Mr. Keenan made a motion to enter into Executive Session to deliberate on complaint matters. Mr. Warner seconded the motion. Motion carried by Mr. Villines and Mr. Blue. After discussion of the matters presented, the Board reopened the meeting to make an official vote on the decision.

#### **Open Session:**

Mr. Villines declared the meeting open.

#### **Complaints:**

**PDSA060036:** Mr. Keenan made the motion to forward the case to the Attorney General's Office to issue a Summary Suspension of the license. Mr. Keenan cited O.C.G.A. § 50-13-18 (c) (1) as the basis for the motion, which states, "The agency finds that the public health, safety, or welfare imperatively requires emergency action and incorporates a finding to that effect in its order, in which case summary suspension of a license may be ordered pending proceedings for revocation or other action, which proceeding shall be promptly instituted and determined."

Mr. Warner seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Blue made the motion to request an inspection of the subject in PDSA060036 within 48 hours after service of the Summary Suspension to determine compliance with the order.

Mr. Warner seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

**Legislation:**

The Board entered into discussion of pending legislative amendments to O.C.G.A. § 43-38, the “Georgia Private Detective & Security Agencies Act.” Updates on the proposed amendments will be made by Mr. Villines at the February 23, 2006 meeting of the Board.
