Georgia Board of Private Detective and Security Agencies  
Thursday April 20, 2006

**Minutes Approved at the June 22, 2006 Meeting**

The Georgia Board of Private Detective and Security Agencies held its regular meeting on April 20, 2006 at 237 Coliseum Drive, Macon, Georgia. Mr. John Villines, Chairman called the meeting to order at 9:20 a.m.

A quorum was established with members present being: John Villines, chairman, Tripp Mitchell, Vice-Chairman, Gary Baker, Cognizant Member, Robert Warner, Board member, Woodrow Blue, Board Member, and Vernon Keenan, Board Member.

Others present were: Steve Lindsey, Executive Director, Ajay Gohill, Assistant Attorney General, Jo Ann Lyde, Application Specialist.

Visitors were as follows: Glenn Christian, Roy Wilkinson, Joe Memolo, and John Roberson.

**Approval of Minutes:**

Mr. Mitchell moved to approve the minutes of the February 23, 2006 meeting with deletion of duplicate information in New Business. Mr. Warner seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**Approval of Agenda:**

Mr. Warner moved to approve today's April 20, 2006 agenda. Mr. Mitchell seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**Open Session:**

Mr. Villines declared Open Session

P.O.S.T. Training Instructors:

Mr. Keenan asked the Board to consider accepting POST-certified training instructors to conduct range score certification without obtaining a license from the Board. The Board discussed the noted differences between the POST firing range curriculum and that of the Board. The Board noted that, while the proposal will create the greatest pool of qualified instructors, it will also create an unfair competition if POST instructors were allowed to conduct range score certifications without the requirement of licensure with the Board. No vote was taken, but the general consensus of the majority of the members was to leave the rules for instructors as it is currently. POST instructors who wish to conduct

range score certifications for persons required to be licensed or registered with the Board must obtain a training instructor license from the Board.

#### HB1259

Mr. Villines invited representative from HTCIA (Computer Forensics Association) to the Board meeting today. Mr. Villines made several trips to the lobby at 9:30 and at 9:45; Representative was not present. The issue is that computer forensics should not be included in Private Detective and Security Agency law. The status of this bill at the present time is that it is waiting Governor's signature, groups in opposition to the bill are trying to get it vetoed.

Mr. Villines also requested continued campaign for support of Governor's signature and thanked members of GAPPI and IPAG for their support. The phone number to the Governor's office was provided.

Mr. Keenan stated that the Board's position of felony for unlicensed practice is warranted because of the opposition.

Mr. Villines stated that HTCIA representative felt many members will not qualify for licensure; however, there is room in PDSA law to qualify them.

Mr. Mitchell moved to set a board policy pending a rule amendment that Board will have option to accept any four year degree relating to definition of Private Detective and Private Security business as qualifying education. Mr. Warner seconded the motion. Motion carried.

#### **Limited Licensure Recognition Agreement:**

Mr. Baker inquired about the process of entering into agreement with SLED. Mr. Baker made a motion to proceed with pursuing an agreement. Mr. Warner seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

#### **Request from Fulton County Police Department:**

Mr. Mitchell made a motion to approve request from Fulton County Police Department on OSHA Security. Mr. Mitchell also made a motion to make it a standard policy for future approval of requests for information from law enforcement and other government agencies in the course of an active investigation. Mr. Warner seconded the motion. Motion carried.

#### **Request for Production of Docs:**

The Board reviewed a Plaintiff's Request for Production of Documents to a Nonparty from Dejan Filipovic. After brief discussion, in which Mr. Villines recused himself from discussion, Mr. Blue moved to table discussion until Executive Session to have in-depth discussion before voting. Mr. Warner seconded. Motion carried with Mr. Villines abstaining.

#### **Letter from Ronald West:**

The Board advised that they will not get into the matter between the union and the agency. The rule regarding carrying weapons off-duty is very specific. Issues of emergencies will have to be taken on a case-by-case basis.

**Homeland Security Training for Security Officers:**

Mr. Vernon Keenan presented information on finalization of a proposal for grant to establish the training program that can also be incorporated into Private Detective and Security Agency training curriculum. The training curriculum will be provided by GBI at no cost.

**Routine Inspections:**

Mr. Baker requested routine inspections of Private Detective and Security companies and provide report on inspections at each meeting. Mr. Warner seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**Executive Session:**

Mr. Mitchell made a motion to enter into Executive Session to deliberate on applications and complaints and to receive information on investigative reports. Mr. Keenan seconded the motion. Motion carried by Mr. Villines, Mr. Blue, Mr. Baker and Mr. Warner.

**Applications:**

Jo Ann Lyde, Application Specialist, presented applications to the Board.

**Appointments:**

The Board met with individuals scheduled for appointments to discuss application issues.

**Investigations:**

Chuck Miller, Investigator, presented investigative reports to the Board

**Attorney General Report:**

Ajay Gohil, Assistant Attorney General, presented a status report.

**Open Session:**

Mr. Villines declared Open Session

**Appeals:**

MR appeared before the Board to appeal the decision of the Board to deny the company license. Mr. Mitchell moved to approve for exam and send to Attorney General's office for license by consent order with probation and requiring the applicant to enroll in Business Management Classes. Mr. Blue seconded the motion. Motion carried.

RL appeared before the Board to appeal the decision of the Board to deny the company license. Mr. Keen moved to approve for licensure upon successful completion of exam. Mr. Warner seconded the motion. Motion carried.

RS appeared before the Board for an appeal of the Board decision to deny the company application for licensure. Mr. Warner moved to approve pending successful completion of exam. Mr. Baker seconded the motion. Motion carried.

JH attended today's Board meeting to appeal the Board's decision in denying application for licensure. The Board advised the the appeal process was exhausted in 2003. Board advised to apply for a security company license.

AO appeared before the Board to appeal Board's decision in denying application for licensure. Mr. Warner requested the office staff to retrieve company file from Archives for review before decision will be made. Place application on agenda for June meeting. Mr. Mitchell seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Colet Odenigbo requested the Board to revisit the previous decision to deny licensure. The appeal process was exhausted previously; however, Mr. Mitchell moved to uphold the Board's decision to deny company application. Mr. Warner seconded the motion. Motion carried.
