Thursday, August 9, 2007

A meeting of the Georgia Board of Private Detective and Security Agencies was held on Thursday, August 9, 2007 at 237 Coliseum Drive, Macon, GA. James T. Mitchell, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 9:05 a.m.

A quorum was established with members present being: James T. Mitchell, Chairman, Robert Warner, Vice-Chair, Gary Baker, Woodrow Blue, Pat Mincey, and John Villines.

Others present were: Steve Lindsey, Executive Director, JoAnn Lyde, Applications Specialist, Laurie Elander, Board Secretary, and Ajay Gohil, Attorney General.

**Approval of Minutes:**

Mr. Warner moved, Mr. Blue seconded, and the Board approved the minutes of the June 21, 2007 minutes.

ISPAG Representative/Joseph S. Memolo attended the meeting to discuss concerns with the renewal process, licensing fees, and communicating procedures with the Licensing Board to include e-mail contact.

Mr. Warner moved, Mr. Villines seconded, and the Board voted to approve the Reinstatement policy set forth by the board, with Mr. Baker opposing.

**Reinstatement policy:** An application for reinstatement must be submitted with all required documentation including fingerprint cards. If application is not received within 60 days, applicant must retake appropriate exam(s) in order to reinstate under a consent agreement to include a fine of \$500.00 per month since August 1, 2007. A notice with a Cease & Desist Order will be sent to all lapsed company licenses notifying them that their company licenses have lapsed and detailing the process of reinstatement. Reinstatement fee for Private Detective Co: \$450.00; Private & In-House Security Co: \$750.00; Private Detective & Security Co: \$1050.00.

Mr. Baker reported on progress of the exam development sub-committee in selecting recommended books for examination preparation. The sub-committee is also assisting the Exam Section in selecting qualified subject matter experts for future exam question bank review.

Mr. Mitchell requested Board input on the possibility of the Board accepting the training requirements of the National Armored Car Industry. The Board expressed a willingness to consider a rule amendment to accept this proposal.

**Executive Session:**

Mr. Villines moved, Mr. Warner seconded, and the Board voted unanimously to enter into Executive Session to deliberate on applications, complaints, and investigations, as authorized by OCGA § 43-1-2 (k) and 43-1-19 (h). The Board concluded Executive Session in order to vote on the matters discussed and to continue with the public session.
