The Georgia State Board of Examiners of Psychologists held a meeting on Friday, September 16, 2005 at the Professional Licensing Boards Division, 237 Coliseum Drive, Macon, Georgia, 31217.

Dr. Webb, Board President, established that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

**Executive Session**

Motion Dr. Meck, seconded Dr. Currie, and motion carried for the Board to enter into Executive Session in accordance with O.C.G.A. §§43-1-2(k) and 43-1-19(h) to deliberate on applications, oral examinations, complaints, and the Assistant Attorney General's report. Voting in favor of the motion were Mr. Douglass, Dr. Sauls, and Dr. Webb. The Board concluded Executive Session in order to vote on these matters and continue with the Public Session.

**Assistant Attorney General's Report**

Ajay Gohil discussed the cases in the Attorney General's office.

**Open Session**

Dr Calhoun, GPA Liaison, reported on pertinent GPA business. Dr. Calhoun also reported that the GPA was in favor of expediting applications of licensed professionals who were evacuated from Louisiana due to Hurricane Katrina.

Motion Dr. Meck, seconded Dr. Currie and motion carried, to issue temporary licenses to applicants evacuated from the areas impacted by Hurricane Katrina who submit the

application, fee, and verification of licensure and who submit within 60 days a doctorate transcript, state verification forms, original EPPP scores, and forms A, G, and two (2) form E's.

The Board has announced that six (6) Continuing Education credits will be awarded to all Psychologists who provide psychological service for the disaster relief. Psychologists must present a letter from the facility where they worked.

As clarification of Rule 510-5-.06(3)(e)(f), before diagnosis is made, the psychologists must **personally** interview patient.
