GPA would like to be kept informed about information to be sent out concerning the biennial renewals to be held this year. Lee Tracy, Executive Director stated that no additional ID would be required this renewal period except for the license number and social security number, without the dashes, of the licensees. Ms. Tracy also stressed that the licensees make sure that they get the receipt from the renewal before exiting the program.

The members of the Board discussed the ASPPB’s model statute and regulations on Interjurisdictional Practice. In principle, with the addition of jurisprudence language, the Georgia Board is in support of the model statutes from ASPPB on Interjurisdictional Practice.

A discussion was held with Inez Lockett and Femi Ajayi of the Exam Development and Testing Section concerning the writing workshop and psychologists selected to take the exam for validity testing purposes.
