At 10:05 a.m., Chairperson Richardson called the meeting to order.

A motion was made by Melissa Henderson, seconded by Guy Middleton; and the Board members present voted unanimously to name Philip Thayer as the Board's vice chairperson effective July 2006.

The Board discussed how to define multifamily structures.

Roger Huggins explained that by definition, a townhome that houses two individual families is Residential Basic in nature, whereas a townhome that houses three or more individual families is multifamily.

A motion was made by Roger Huggins and seconded by Dan Cash to change the General Contractor applications to reflect an acceptance of a maximum of two multifamily buildings that house three or more families as projects for licensure as a General Contractor. The General Contractor Division voted unanimously to accept the motion.

A motion was made by Philip Thayer and seconded by Timothy Ansley to allow Executive Director Kyle Floyd the authority to approve Residential Light Commercial applicants for licensure. The subdivision voted unanimously to accept the motion.

With no other business to discuss, Chairperson Richardson adjourned the meeting at 11:46 a.m.
