At 9:05 a.m., Chairperson Huggins established that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order.

A motion was made by Bob Barnard, seconded by Mark Herbert, and the Board voted unanimously to accept the full Board minutes from December 6, 2006.

Former Board Attorney, Reagan Dean, introduced the Board's new attorney, Rebecca Adams.

A motion was made by Mark Herbert, seconded Bob Barnard, and the Board members present: Mark Herbert, Bob Barnard, Steve Cash, Allen Richardson, Philip Thayer, Timothy Ansley, David Cyr, Tommy Holder, Dan Cash, Roger Huggins, Hoppy Hopkins and Morgan Wheeler voted to enter into Executive Session for the purpose of applicant appearances and the discussion of applications.

A motion was made by Bob Barnard, seconded by David Cyr, and the Board voted unanimously to move back into open session.

Commissioner Bill Collins, representing the City of Rome, Georgia, presented the Board with constituent based concerns regarding the requirements for obtaining a General Contractor's license. Specifically, Mr. Collins had concerns that the requirements of net worth, line of credit, and background checks would cause a strain on minorities and small business owners. Mr. Collins also expressed concerns regarding how the information regarding the new licensure requirements was distributed to the public.

Bob Barnard explained to Commissioner Collins that as a Board, they could not change the law. Mr. Barnard went on to suggest that Commissioner Collins speak with his legislative member to address the specific requirements in the law that Mr. Collins addressed.

Philip Thayer responded to Mr. Collin's concerns by explaining the three tiers of licensure.

Mr. Collins again asked why this information was not distributed.

Executive Director, Kyle Floyd, explained that he gave several speeches that were sponsored by the Secretary of State's office. That information was advertised on the Secretary of State's website and through a press release. Mr. Floyd also informed Mr. Collins that in January of 2005, his staff sent letters informing building officials in each Georgia county and municipality of examination exemption and the new licensing

requirements. That information was supposed to be posted by these officials for public, including contractors', viewing.

While Mr. Collins left the Board room to fulfill another obligation, discussion regarding this issue continued.

Chairperson Huggins suggested that perhaps this Board needed a subcommittee to insure that information is being widely distributed to small business owners and minorities.

Morgan Wheeler responded to Chairperson Huggins' statement by suggesting that Chairperson Huggins needed to push for the consumer Board member position be filled. Mr. Wheeler explained that it would be the consumer Board member that would work to distribute this information to the public.

Mr. Wheeler went on to suggest that Chairperson Huggins examine tiers to the General Contractor license as well.

Chairperson Huggins restated that the Board was put in place to protect the public without having an economic impact. He went on to say that this Board has to find a good balance between the two.

A motion was made by Bob Barnard, seconded by Hoppy Hopkins, and the Board members present: Bob Barnard, Hoppy Hopkins, Allen Richardson, Morgan Wheeler, Dan Cash, Steve Cash, Philip Thayer, Roger Huggins, David Cyr, Tommy Holder, Mark Herbert and Timothy Ansley voted to enter into Executive Session to continue the discussion of applications.

A motion was made by David Cyr, seconded by Bob Barnard, and the Board voted unanimously to move back into open session.

The discussion regarding "limited service contractors" was tabled for the February 14, 2007 Board meeting.

The Board discussed how they have previously handled applicants with criminal convictions.

A motion was made by Steve Cash, seconded by Hoppy Hopkins, and the Board voted unanimously to reconsider all previous denials of applicants with a nole crossed status.

Board Attorney, Reagan Dean, confirmed that the Board may reconsider the denial of particular applicants.

Allen Richardson suggested that the Board reconsider particular applicants that were previously denied on the basis of a criminal conviction after the bulk of examination exemption applications were processed and reviewed.

During discussion of this motion, the Board requested that this information be distributed in a summary form so they may reconsider their position. Board Secretary, Alison Kessler, distributed that information to all Board members at the meeting, and nolle prosequi applicants were indicated. The Board agreed to review this and discuss at the next meeting.

Executive Director, Kyle Floyd, delivered the Executive Director's report to the Board members, which included an update of testing vendors, the presentation of correspondence from particular applicants, and how to handle applications post-marked after the deadline of January 3, 2007 for examination exemption applications.

Mr. Floyd informed the Board that testing vendors were currently being narrowed down to administer the examination for licensure.

In response to the correspondence Mr. Floyd presented to the Board, which included architect responses to prior Board correspondence, the Board acknowledged such but no further action was taken.

The Board discussed how to handle applications post-marked after the deadline. Board Attorney, Reagan Dean, confirmed that the Board does not have any leeway with the legal deadline set forth in O.C.G.A § 43-41-17(a). The Board took note of Mr. Dean's opinion and agreed that any application postmarked or hand-delivered after January 3, 2007 would be unacceptable.
