### **International Licensure Issues**

In addition, Mrs. Stegall moved that the Board of Nursing not support NCLEX-VISA Screen proposed by the NCSBN. Applicants must meet the requirements for licensure by Examination as outlined in the Board of Nursing Rules and Regulations 410-6-.02. Dr. Darden seconded the motion and it carries unanimously.

**RNI040338**- Mrs. Stegall moved to write the nurse a letter requesting an outpatient M/P/E utilizing guidelines for Mental Physical Examination, as part of the application for licensure by examination. Results are to be reviewed by the Cognizant Board Member and the Nursing Consultant for Disciplinary Action. If warranted, refer to the Attorney General's office for a Hearing or Consent Order utilizing evaluation results and/or recommendations. If not warranted, close case. Dr. Darden seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
