QMA Report - Barbara Mitchell, QMA Taskforce Board representative:

A QMA Meeting was held September 28th 2007. Dr Lisa Beck (Curriculum Specialist) has now joined the task force as a DTAE representative replacing the Atlanta Tech faculty previously serving. There are no

classes scheduled to begin at this time. Southwest Georgia Tech, an additional pilot site voted on by this Bard will now be presented to the DTAE Board for their approval. Griffin Technical is interested in becoming a QMA pilot site as well.

AAG Janet Jackson expressed her appreciation for this Board cooperation in getting this joint project up and running. There is disappointment by all parties involved of the student interest/participation in the pilot project; currently only two individuals have been certified as QMA's.

Ms. Mitchell discussed the search for additional pilot sites to expand the program to other parts of the state in an effort to generate interest. Southwest Georgia Tech is the first of several additional sites to be considered. There appears to be more interest in the program in the SW part of the state. In addition, Ms. Mitchell also expressed that students must complete and submit their applications for certification prior to being made eligible to sit for the QMA Competency exam, just as our current LPN program students do. The full Board agreed.

Commission on Graduates of Foreign Nursing Schools (CGFNS): Presentation

Sylvia Pomponi, Legislative & Regulatory Specialist and Donna Richardson, Director of Governmental Affairs and Professional Standards conducted a presentation to the Board of the services and resources available to regulatory boards by CGFNS with regard to credentials evaluation and verification services pertaining to the education, registration and licensure of nurses and healthcare professionals worldwide. Ms. Richardson explained their role in immigration and VISA's as well. She stated the organization also has concerns regarding the recent reports of fraudulent documents, the recent breach of the NCLEX exam in the Philippines and the "international movement" to promote nursing as an "easy" way for individuals to come to the US.

Ms. Pomponi explained the programs and services offered by/through CGFNS:

- Certification program (RN's only – exam required before an RN can sit for the NCLEX)
- Credentials and Evaluation Service (LPN's) – this is not an exam but a credentials evaluation report
- New York – a service only available to New York (i.e. designed specifically for NY)

Ms. Pomponi explained that the organization maintains an internal listing of schools identified by CGFNS as fraudulent and will notify the appropriate Board when an individual applies with them. Ms. Gadson, Application Specialist II stated we are not receiving these reports. Ms. Pomponi stated this process has just been started by CGFNS and she will check on the reason but suspects they may be going to the RN Board versus the LPN Board in error. In addition, she will forward by e-mail an internet site offering a very good, up to date comprehensive listing of schools known to be fraudulent.
