Liaison Report: Hattie O'Bryant

Ms. O'Bryant has stated that the LPN Day at the Capitol held March 3, 2008 was a great success; reminded Board of the October 20, 2008 GLPNA annual meeting in Albany, Georgia:

- o Secretary of State Handel addressed the group; held a brief question and answer session;
- o Most of the questions asked were concerning the QMA'S;
- o LPN'S see the QMA'S as a threat to their jobs.

Ms. O'Bryant stated if the LPN Board had any suggestions for the committee to please let her know.

Ms. Mack inquired about extending the LPN day at the Capitol; She stated that a lot of students would like to attend but letting them miss one or two hours of classes is not beneficial to the students.

QMA Report - Barbara Mitchell, QMA Taskforce Board representative:

Ms. Mitchell did not have any new information. There are currently no students enrolled in the QMA program. We only have 2 students in Georgia that have obtained QMA Certification.

Correspondence:

- The Board receive a letter from Dave R Root, LPN concerning the scope of practice:
 1. Is it appropriate and within the scope of practice for (LPN's) to be doing unsupervised procedures (such as I&D'S, suturing, and ingrown toe nail removals) that require an Op (Operation) permit?

Board Response: No, these tasks are inappropriate for LPN's to be done unsupervised.

2. (Is it ok) For LPN'S to administer an immunization per standing order that is only signed off in electronic patient record by LPN, no counter signature by a provider?

Board Response: Assuming there is a "standing order", then yes.

- The Board received a letter from Barbara Dunn expressing concern that some LPN'S are practicing in Georgia assisted living (AL) residences without supervision required by Georgia Code.

Board Response: Appears to be an ORS (Office of Regulatory Services) issue. If complaints are filed against specific LPN's employed in AL facilities, then the Board would look into such allegations. LPN's can not delegate tasks that a licensed person should perform to an unlicensed person.

- E-mail request to complete a scope of practice survey regarding "LPN Telephone Triage"

Board Response: The Board does not interpret the LPN Practice Act.

Ms. Dumas moved, Ms. Owensby seconded and the Board voted for the administrative staff to respond to all correspondence received as directed above.

Ms. Dumas moved and Ms. Owensby seconded and the Board voted to enter into Executive Session in accordance with O.C.G.A. §43-1-2(k)(1), (2) and (4); §43-1-19(h)(2), (3) and (4) and O.C.G.A. §43-1-19(h); 50-14-2(1) to deliberate on the Cognizant Report, Investigations, and Applications, and, receive information on the Cognizant report and Applications. Voting in favor of the motion were Ms. Mitchell, Ms. Mack, Ms Dumas, Ms. Hilliard, Ms. Owensby, and Ms. Harte. The Board concluded executive session in order to vote on these matters and to continue with the public session.
